

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Gospel of Matthew

It would be useful for us today to reflect on the meaning of our own baptism and how it relates with that of Jesus. We often hear a very simplistic description of the effects of the Sacrament of Baptism as 'taking away original sin and making us children of God.' Many, especially those baptized as infants, may see it as a one-off ceremony, imposed on them by parents to bind them to a way of life in which they have no further say. However, if one truly understands the full meaning of our baptism, this is unlikely to happen.

Baptism is not, as is true of all the Sacraments, an isolated ritual. It takes place in the context of our whole life. Whether we are baptized as children or as adults, what primarily is happening is that we become incorporated, 'embodied', into the Christian community.

We become—not passively, but actively—members of the Body of Christ. It can never be something imposed on us against our will. That is why, for adults, there is now a long process of initiation leading up to Baptism and, hopefully, a further process of community support after the Baptism has taken place.

We are called to be living witnesses of the Gospel, to be the salt of the earth, to be a city on a hill, a candle radiating light in the surrounding darkness. We are called, in short, to be united with the others in our Christian community in the building up of God's Kingdom.

Our baptism is not simply some past event recorded in some dusty parish register. It is a living reality which is to be constantly deepened and enriched.

Seeing Your Life Through the Lens of the Gospel

1) Jesus, the sinless Son of God, embraces humility and insists on being baptized to 'fulfill all righteousness.' He joins Himself with humanity's need for repentance. Am I too willing to embrace humility? Am I prone to avoiding situations that I think beneath me, or like Christ, am I willing to enter into the struggles of others to serve and fulfill God's purpose?

2) Jesus' baptism wasn't about confessing personal sin but about obediently inaugurating His mission. His submission to the Father's plan is the model for our own discipleship. There is a difference between just following rituals and inner obedience to God. Is my faith expressed through active steps of obedience to God's will, even when I don't fully understand it?

3) Before Jesus performed any miracles or preached any sermons, the Father affirmed His identity: 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.' Our worth as a human being is not rooted in our productivity or success but in being God's beloved child through Christ. Am I living and striving for a love and approval that I already possess by God's grace?

4) At Jesus' baptism the Trinity is uniquely revealed. the Son in the water, the Spirit descending, the Father speaking. This illustrates the communal nature of God. My faith invites me into this divine relationship. As I reflect on the quality of my connection with God, I ask myself is it a distant transaction, or an intimate, relational communion with the Father, through the Son, in the power of the Spirit?





Saint Marguerite Bourgeoys
Feast Day: January 12th



Growing up in Troyes, France, Marguerite formed a special relationship with Our Lady. She was turned away by two religious communities, but met the founder of Montreal, Canada, when he returned to France to visit his sister. He invited Marguerite to open a school in the New World; she went, despite misgivings, after praying to Mary. From that first school in an abandoned stable, her ministry grew to include teaching women crafts and founding the Sisters of the Congregation of Notre Dame. She managed to keep her sisters uncloistered, despite opposition from the bishop, and served as superior for many years. When Pope John Paul II canonized her in 1982, she became Canada's first female saint.

Saint Anthony of Egypt, Abbot
Feast Day: January 17th

Associated with the beginnings of monasticism, Anthony gave his inherited lands and wealth in Egypt to the poor. From the age of about 20 until his death at 105 years old, he lived as a hermit in remote hilltop and desert locations. What is known about him comes from a hagiography written by St. Athanasius of Alexandria. Around the year 306, Anthony began to accept disciples, founding his first monastery as a collection of hermits' cells. He cultivated a garden, wove rush mats, and fought many temptations and demons. Visitors sought his wise counsel, collected in the sayings of the "desert fathers," and the bishops of Alexandria summoned him at age 87 to help refute Arianism. He is the patron of basket and brush makers, butchers, gravediggers, and skin diseases.





The Baptism of the Lord

The origin and foundation of Christian Baptism is Jesus. Before starting his public ministry, Jesus submitted himself to the baptism given by John the Baptist. The waters did not purify him; he cleansed the waters. "He comes to sanctify the Jordan for our sake... to begin a new creation through the Spirit and water" (St. Gregory Nazianzen, Liturgy of the Hours. 1, 634). Jesus' immersion in the water is a sign for all human beings of the need to die to themselves to do God's will. Jesus did not need to be baptized because he was totally faithful to the will of his Father and free from sin.

However, he wanted to show his solidarity with human beings in order to reconcile them to the Father. By commanding his disciples to baptize all nations, he established the means by which people would die to sin—Original and actual—and begin to live a new life with God.


