Gospel of Matthew

To Love and To Trust

Today, the Gospel offers us a monologue from Jesus, a lengthy teaching asking us to be warned against the thought processes and vacuous facades of the Scribes and Pharisees. Our everyday lives are full of risk. Spiritual risk. We can adopt those facades ourselves, indeed, we *do* adopt them. Jesus is asking us to check ourselves, to not fall into the same spiritual trap.

The freedom that God gives us to follow our own conscience is itself one of the greatest dangers, because we are at our own wheel; we are our own coxswain. We steer, plot, navigate, and make the decisions about the journey that we take, the journey through life. But God wants this freedom in our hearts. He wishes us to come freely into his kingdom, into his eternity.

This freedom is what we must keep in mind daily, moment by moment. By considering God's Scripture in our hearts whenever we make decisions, whenever we speak to our neighbor, whenever we struggle with doubt and temptation, by keeping God close we are giving ourselves the best opportunity to let grace take charge, for the Spirit to steer us. If we ask, God will reply. If we seek Him, He shall come. Freely coming to God in trust, asking him to intervene, would have been anathema in the eyes of the Pharisees. And, as Jesus said, 'For I tell you, if your virtue goes no deeper than that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never get into the kingdom of heaven.'

Our virtue is to love and to trust, to make our own journey, but also to ask God to be the waves that steer us, the wind that draws us. If our words are empty, if we seek God only in hushed prayer, but not in our relationships, then we shall be lost. Lost, spiritually, and lost to God's kingdom.

Points To Ponder

Many of Jesus' contemporaries whose dedication to keeping every dot and title of the law can only be described as admirable. However, their sense of satisfaction was severely challenged when Jesus indicated that the law was not enough. He did not abolish the law, rather housed it as a launching pad to propel his fallowers beyond the mere letter of the law to the spirit that lay behind it. Jesus challenged his disciples to a holiness that reached far beyond the law - perfect legal observance would not be enough, but rather a good start. No doubt many were disappointed and even angry. But there were others who were able to look with Jesus beyond the law to the loving God who inspired it. Those who accepted Jesus' challenge would begin to frame their lives with new questions - What more can I do? What more can I become? Some responses to these questions are answered in today's Gospel by a series of listed obligations of the law. For instance, the law against murder must also include hatred, anger and scorn. The law against false oaths would also include integrity, so that our 'yes' is really yes and our 'no' is really no. This is to show that people are valued more than legal observance and that our friendship with God hinges heavily upon our bonding with other people. Our offering of a gift to God is insincere if we withhold forgiveness from one another. Until the reign of God is established and acknowledged in every human heart, Jesus challenges us to move beyond the mere letter of the law to that area of grace where love knows no limits.







Why Ashes? *By Fr. Larry Rice*

For centuries, Catholic Christians have marked the beginning of the season of Lent by receiving ash on their foreheads on Ash Wednesday. This tradition has its roots in the Old Testament, where wearing ashes was a common sign of repentance for sins, and a sign of one's humility before God. Since Lent is a season of penitential renewal through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, it's appropriate that this ancient sign marks the beginning of the season. The ashes themselves are usually made by burning the palm fronds from the previous year's Palm Sunday. This symbolically connects the beginning of Lent with its end, connecting our change of heart with Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. Ashes are usually distributed as part of the Mass on Ash Wednesday, often after the homily. As people approach the priest or other minister, he presses the ashes to their foreheads, and speaks one of two phrases: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," or "Repent and believe in the Gospel." In many places, Ash Wednesday services are among the most popular of the whole year—a day that's not even a Holy Day of Obligation. Cynics have suggested that this is because people "get" something, as they do on Palm Sunday. But there's nothing particularly appealing about getting smudged with ashes. Perhaps the appeal is the expression through a physical sign of a desire for interior conversion. The Gospel for Ash Wednesday is a reminder that the real purpose of the season of Lent isn't to make public demonstrations of piety even the wearing of ashes but to seek conversion of heart.




