FIRST READING**A Reading from The Book of Genesis**
Genesis 2:7-9; 3:1-7

The LORD God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and so man became a living being.

Then the LORD God planted a garden in Eden, in the east, and placed there the man whom he had formed.

Out of the ground the LORD God made various trees grow that were delightful to look at and good for food, with the tree of life in the middle of the garden and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Gospel of Matthew

Temptation for Jesus meant the same as it meant for Adam and Eve and as it also means for us. It meant choosing between good and evil, between doing God's will or one's own will. Jesus was tempted right through his whole life. His victory in the desert was not the winning of the war, but merely the winning of a battle. We can't hope to escape temptation; temptation is the struggle between the passions of the flesh and the longings of the spirit. It is not something to be ashamed of - our destiny isn't simply never to fall, but having fallen, to rise again. Temptation is not necessarily a bad thing, but by forcing us to choose good over evil it makes us strong. Virtue would become meaningless if there was no evil, no struggle. The battle against evil is never over as long as we are alive. However, each right choice makes the next right choice that much easier. Jesus victory wasn't easy. It was achieved through prayer, fasting and reflection on the will of the heavenly Father with the help of the Holy Spirit. He is with us also in our struggles. It is a great consolation this Lent to consider in our hearts that God is not outside our struggles but is with us during them. There is one aspect of gardening that most gardeners find difficult - the job of pruning fruit trees. And yet if pruning is neglected the results can be very disappointing. Pruning time is a painful time for a fruit tree. The pruner rids it of all those suckers which use up a lot of energy but produce no fruit. However, the aim of this surgery is not to inflict pain, but to help the tree to produce more and better fruit. Lent is a kind of spiritual pruning time. There is much that is useless and perhaps harmful in our lives which saps our energy and diminishes our spiritual fruitfulness. We ask the question... 'of what shall we proud ourselves this Lent so that we may become more fruitful branches of Christ, the true Vine?'

Points To Ponder

In the New Testament, the Greek word *baptizein* means to dip or to plunge. The Acts of the Apostles indicates that a laying-on of hands after the water rite was associated with the conferral of the Holy Spirit (8:14-20; 19:6).

In the Old Testament the prophets announced that the Spirit of the Lord would rest on the hoped-for Messiah for his saving mission. Jesus asserts that this promise is now fulfilled in him. The descent of the Holy Spirit on Jesus at his baptism by John was the sign that he is the Messiah, the 'one who is to come.' He was conceived by the Holy Spirit; his whole life and mission are carried out in total communion with the Holy Spirit whom the Father gives without measure.

The Hebrew word 'Messiah' means 'anointed one'. It is translated as 'Christos' in Greek. Christ means 'anointed one' and Christians are the 'anointed ones' who share in the messianic mission of Christ. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, we who are reborn in the waters of baptism are anointed to proclaim the kingdom of God. The anointing 'Christifies' those who receive it as it bestows the gift of the Holy Spirit.



What is the true purpose of Lent beyond “giving something up”?

Lent is much more about creating a stronger relationship with God than it is about anything else. But with any relationship, there has to be love. A relationship without love will fall apart, and that’s why it’s so important to create a connection that is built on love, rather than material things. When you commit to loving someone, that means you should also be willing to sacrifice for them. You should be willing to give up your time, your energy, or even certain hobbies to spend time with the other person so you can create a stronger relationship. *“This is what I’m willing to do out of love for you.”* When God sees you trying, that means something to Him, just as it would to anyone else in your life that you’re willing to sacrifice for. But it’s important to remember that Lent is a *two step* process. Just giving something up is not enough to form a stronger relationship with God. You have to connect, whether that’s through extra prayers, studying the Bible, or anything else that allows you to spend more time with the Lord. 



This disciple of St. John the Apostle was appointed bishop of Smyrna (now Izmir, Turkey), perhaps by John. Representing the Asia Minor churches, he went to Rome about 155 to discuss when to celebrate Easter. The result was that the Eastern and Western churches continued to calculate the date as before. Shortly after his return, Polycarp was arrested and urged to renounce God. He refused and was sentenced to be burned alive. When the flames did not harm him, he was killed by a sword, as recounted in an early Christian document.




