**GOSPEL****A Reading from The Gospel according to John  
John 11:3-7, 17, 20-27, 33b-45**

The sisters of Lazarus sent word to Jesus, saying, "Master, the one you love is ill." When Jesus heard this he said, "This illness is not to end in death, but is for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it." Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. So when he heard that he was ill, he remained for two days in the place where he was. Then after this he said to his disciples, "Let us go back to Judea." When Jesus arrived, he found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days. When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went to meet him; but Mary sat at home. Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. But even now I know that whatever you ask of God, God will give you." Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise." Martha said, "I know he will rise, in the resurrection on the last day." Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" She said to him, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world." He became perturbed and deeply troubled, and said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to him, "Sir, come and see." And Jesus wept. So the Jews said, "See how he loved him." But some of them said, "Could not the one who opened the eyes of the blind man have done something so that this man would not have died?" So Jesus, perturbed again, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay across it. Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the dead man's sister, said to him, "Lord, by now there will be a stench; he has been dead for four days." Jesus said to her, "Did I not tell you that if you believe you will see the glory of God?" So they took away the stone. And Jesus raised his eyes and said, "Father, I thank you for hearing me. I know that you always hear me; but because of the crowd here I have said this, that they may believe that you sent me." And when he had said this, He cried out in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" The dead man came out, tied hand and foot with burial bands, and his face was wrapped in a cloth. So Jesus said to them, "Untie him and let him go." Now many of the Jews who had come to Mary and seen what he had done began to believe in him.

## *Gospel of John*

Imagine yourself to be Martha or Mary, disappointed that the Lord did not act in time. What's the point of having Jesus as a friend, if He does not come to our aid when we need Him?

God's delays are not denials. Take that in for a moment. He has a plan and a purpose.

Jesus delays this trip; in a way it seems to be a bit cruel to the ones He loved dearly. After all He worked miracles for those who did not even ask for it, like the cripple. These were people He loved; so why did He delay? Was it because at the end of chapter ten we are told that the Jews wanted to stone Him? Not at all in John 11:8, when He announces His intention to go to Bethany, His own disciples dissuade Him, for fear of the Jews.

Jesus was no stranger to raising people from the dead. He had raised Jarius daughter and the only son of the widow of Nain. But both these had died the same day they were raised to life and the sceptics had it going that the soul had not left the body, which means that Jesus had not. 'really raised them from the dead' because they were merely in a coma.' Strange as it may sound, this was a Jewish belief. The Jews believed that the soul did not leave the body for four days: it kind of hovered around the body hoping to get in again, Jesus, decided to make it clear that the Lazarus miracle is to be a sign that Jesus really is the power of life, evident in the resurrection. Why does the Lord delay our pleas for help? Jesus does not work signs and wonders for our benefit. The Lord indeed loves us, but that does not mean He has to hear our every cry for help in the way we want it. In His time, He makes all things beautiful. If only we believe this: for God's delays are not necessarily His denials. Think about it, God is not late, maybe 1 am early!

## *Points To Ponder*

Set against the backdrop of Jesus' impending Death, many elements of the raising of Lazarus foreshadow the good news of Jesus' own Resurrection, Jesus, facing the conflict with the Jewish authorities, acts in complete obedience to God. In raising Lazarus, Jesus shows his power over death so that when Jesus dies, those who believe in him might remember that and take hope. Just as Jesus calls for the stone to be rolled away from Lazarus's tomb, so too will the disciples find the stone rolled away from Jesus tomb. Likewise, each of us, as a result of our Baptism, can recognize how Jesus has rolled away the stones of our own tombs and called us to new life. We, in turn, are sent forth to bring hope of new life to others who are entombed by suffering, despair, and injustice.

Who are some of the people/groups of people in society today who are entombed by suffering, despair, and injustice?

How can we bring hope and new life to those who are 'entombed' by these realities?

When was a time that someone brought hope and new life to you?

What are some of the 'stones that need to be 'rolled away' in our society so that people may truly be free from injustice?

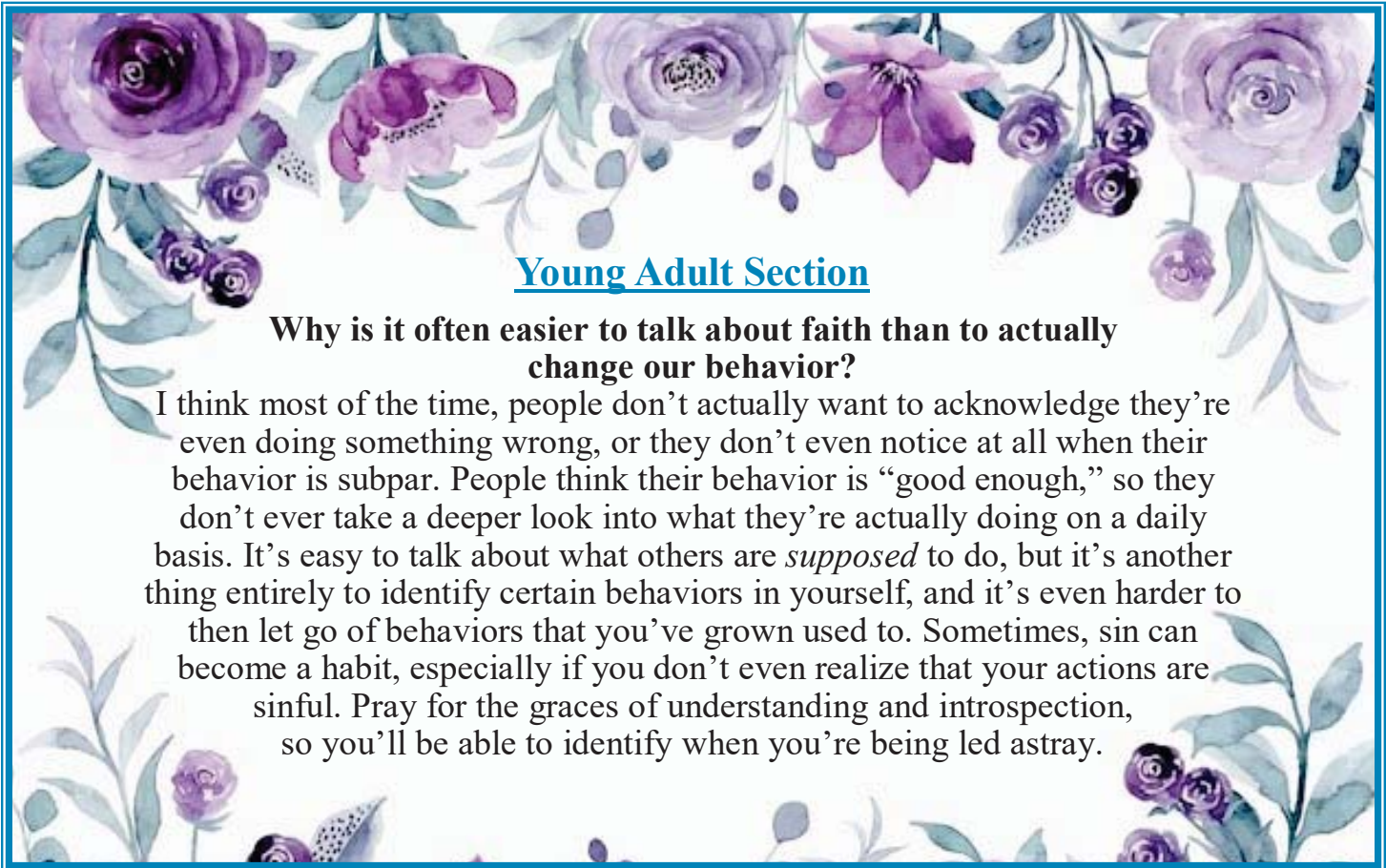

## Saint Turibius of Mogrovejo

*Feast Day: March 23*

Spanish-born Turibius taught law in Salamanca until 1574, when he was appointed inquisitor of Granada. In 1580, though not yet a priest, he was named archbishop of Lima, Peru, with his episcopal ordination in Seville. After arriving in Lima in 1581, his 25 years of missionary service included diocesan and provincial synods, visits around the vast diocese, clergy reforms, and Indian-language catechisms. He also introduced European religious orders into Peru, opened the first seminary in the New World and encouraged Indians to become priests.

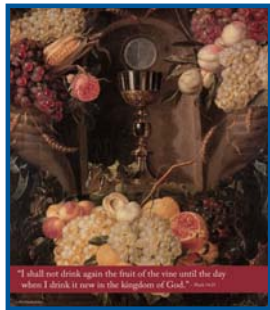

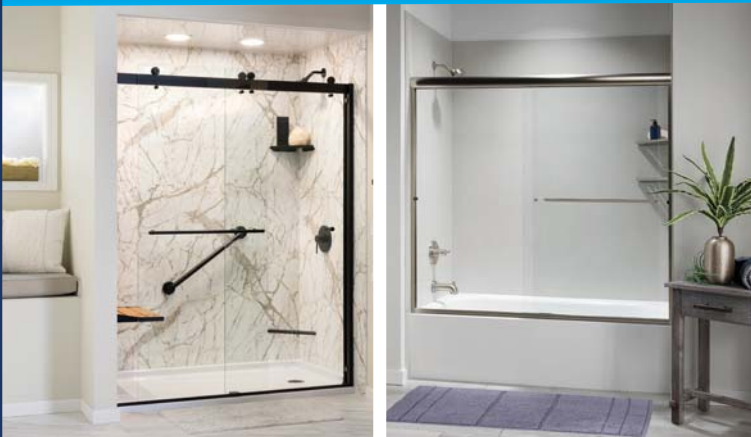
