Gospel of John

John 14:15-21 is a passage about consolation and promise in the face of fear, loss, and despair. Jesus is speaking to His disciples about his imminent death but reassuring them that He will nevertheless be alive with them and close to them (that is, resurrected in their hearts), especially through the presence and comfort of the 'spirit of truth' which He later refers to as the Holy Spirit. While this is all very mysterious, we believe that everyone who has experienced the loss of a loved one, or despair over the suffering and loss of so many innocent lives in this world, faces the same mystery. In response, we see this poetic passage from the Gospel of John as a message of hope. It begins with Jesus admonishing His disciples that 'if you love me, you will keep my commands,' and the most essential commandments he shared with his followers were to love thy God with all thy heart and all thy soul and all thy mind' and to love thy neighbor as thyself.' We believe that the second of these commandments is essential to the first, because the way to love God 'with all your heart, soul, and mind' is to treat others in the way you would want them to treat you: first, to love yourself and then to love others, coequally. This is known as the 'golden rule,' and it is articulated with in virtually every major world religion. To love God with all your heart and mind and soul is:

- To love others as you hope they will love you.
 - To honor others as you hope they will honor you.
 - To respect others as you hope they will respect you.
 - To listen to others as you hope they will listen to you.
 - To care for others as you hope they will care for you.
 - To cherish others as you hope they will cherish you.
 - To delight in others as you hope they will delight in you.
 - To forgive others as you hope they will forgive you.
 - To bless others as you hope they will bless you.
- To find the divine in others as you hope they will find the divine in you.

Points To Ponder

We are only a little under three weeks now from the feast of Pentecost, which we celebrate on Sunday two weeks. It is hard to believe we are already more than halfway through the seven-week season of Easter. As we get closer to the feast of Pentecost, we will begin to hear more references to the Holy Spirit in the readings that are proclaimed at Mass. In this morning's gospel reading Jesus says to his disciples, 'the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I have said to you.' It is the evening before Jesus is put to death; his disciples are aware that Jesus is taking his leave of them. In that highly charged hour Jesus assures them that his leaving them, his death, will not be the end of his relationship with them. He will send the Holy Spirit from the Father who will remind them of all Jesus said to them. Jesus' relationship with them will endure in and through the Holy Spirit.

Jesus is present to all of us, within all of us, in and through the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit brings Jesus to us today and brings us to Jesus. That is why we need to keep on praying, 'Come Holy Spirit, fill my heart.' We keep asking the Spirit we have already received to keep on filling us more and more, filling our thoughts, words, deeds, filling our very being, so that our relationship with the Lord will continue to deepen.

Novena in Honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus
Begins Thursday, June 4th

Prayer: Our Lord Jesus, in your Holy Gospel by Matthew you tell us: "Ask, and you shall receive; seek, and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." Behold me kneeling at Your feet, filled with a lively faith and confidence in the promises dictated by Your Sacred Heart and pronounced by Your adorable lips, I come to ask this favor: (*Here mention your petitions*) To whom can I turn, if not to You whose Heart is the source of all graces and merits? Where should I seek, if not in the treasure which contains all the riches of Your kindness and mercy? Where must I knock if not at the door through which God gives himself to us and through which we go to God? I have recourse to You, Heart of Jesus? In you I find consolation when afflicted, protection when persecuted, strength when burdened with trials, and light in doubt and darkness.

First Day: I kneel before you and adore your Divine Heart. No matter how often I have sinned against you I shall not despair because I know that you are God infinite in generosity and mercy always ready to pardon every contrite and humble sinner. O compassionate Heart of Jesus, grant me comfort. O Heart of my omnipotent God, Have mercy on me. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Second Day: I, with a contrite heart cast myself at your feet weeping over my sins and promising you that in the future I shall rather die than offend you again. O sweetest Heart of Jesus help me with your grace so that may carry out my resolution. Then, O Jesus, if my wishes are not contrary to your most holy will I beg of you (here mention your intentions) for which I pray with confidence and which I hope to receive from your infinite Sacred Heart. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Third Day: I firmly believe that You can grant me the grace I implore, even though it should require a miracle. You have only to will it, and my prayer will be granted. I admit that I am most unworthy of Your favors, but this is not a reason for me to be discouraged. Cast upon me a look of mercy, I beg of You, and Your kind heart will find in my miseries and weakness a reason for granting my prayer. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Fourth Day: O Sacred Heart of Jesus, whatever may be Your decision with regard to my request, I will never stop adoring, loving, praising, and serving You. My Jesus, be pleased to accept this my act of perfect resignation to the decrees of Your adorable Heart which I sincerely desire may be fulfilled in and by me and all Your creatures forever. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Fifth Day: Sacred Heart of Jesus, I know that there is but one thing impossible to You: to be without pity for those who are suffering or in distress. Look upon me, I beg of You, dear Jesus, and grant me the grace for which I humbly implore You, through the Immaculate Heart of Your most sorrowful Mother. You have entrusted me to her as her child, and her prayers are all-powerful with You. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Sixth Day: O Lord, I pray that in my home, peace, quiet and well being may prevail under the shadow of Your holy mantle. Bless and protect, O Lord, my endeavors, my enterprises, and all those who depend on me and everything that I long for and desire. Banish from my mind and my heart false ideas and evil sentiments. I pray for the assistance of Your Sacred Heart in all moments of weakness. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Seventh Day: Infuse in me a love of my neighbor and grant me the means to help him. Give me resignation and fortitude of spirit in time of adversity, so that I may rise above the contradictions of life. Guide and protect, O Lord, my own who are exposed to the dangers and contingencies of the world. Heart of Jesus, burning for love of me inflame my heart with love for you. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Eighth Day: Do not forget, O my Jesus, our loved ones with whom we are united in life and whose departure from this earth caused us sorrow, at the same time consoled by the thought that, because they remained faithful to You, You did not abandon them at the hour of death. Have pity on them, O Lord, and bring them their eternal glory in heaven. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

Ninth Day: Adorable Savior, Jesus Christ, I believe what your holy word teaches. I believe that you offer sacrifices forever in the fire of your love through your Sacred Heart. I place all my needs with great confidence into your merciful Heart. Heart of Jesus, bruised for our sins and pierced with a lance, have mercy on us. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory.*

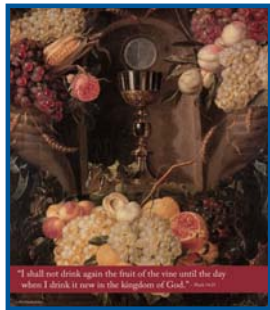

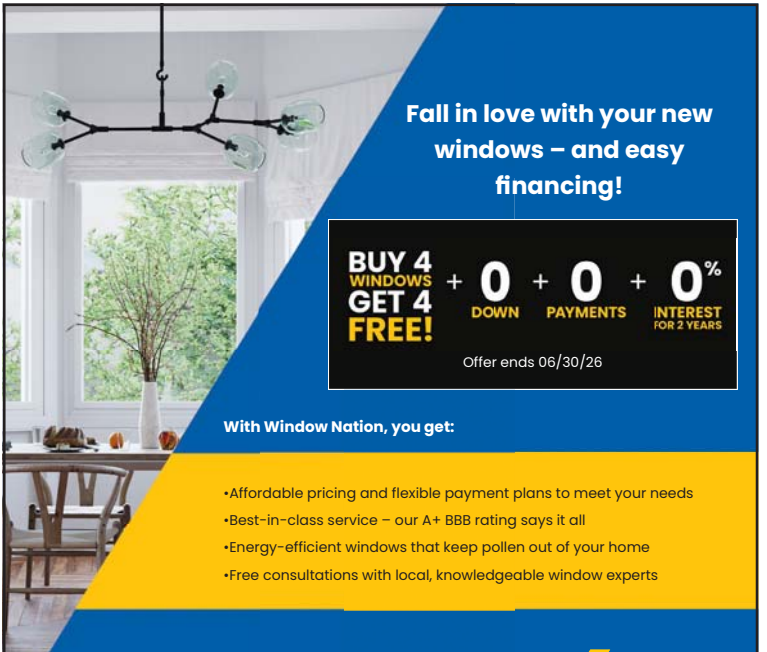
