When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.

As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.

## *Gospel of John*

The first reading for today's feast of Pentecost shows us what the Spirit does if people are open to the coming of the Spirit. The Spirit works to bring together in Christ, people from very different traditions and cultures. You could say that the Spirit helps us to discover and give expression to that deeper language that is common to all of us as human beings. Whenever people of very different cultures and background recognize each other as brothers and sisters under one God, there the Holy Spirit is at work. Whenever we speak in a way that finds an echo in the hearts of people who are very different from us, there the Holy Spirit is at work.

Jesus is the supreme example of someone who spoke in such a way. He was a Jew and yet what he said touched a chord in the hearts of Jews, Samaritans and pagans alike. Whenever we act in ways that draw people together who appear to have very little in common, there the Holy Spirit is at work. Whenever we work to reconcile those who are estranged, there the Holy Spirit is moving. In situations of conflict, there will always be some people who work tirelessly to build bridges rather than blow up bridges. Such people, in the words of today's second reading, are 'under the influence of the Holy Spirit.'

We are all very aware that in the world in which we live, the blowing up of bridges can be more to the fore than the building of them. Some people seem to be intent on driving deeper and deeper wedges between those already estranged. There are forces at work in the world that are the opposite of the force or power of the Holy Spirit. We may even be conscious at times of the presence of such forces in our own hearts. We can shut out people simply because they are different to us.

However, today's first reading suggests that a language which is very different from our own can be the language of the Spirit.

## *Points To Ponder*

Imagine yourself in that upper room: doors bolted, hearts pounding, shame and fear swirling after the chaos of the cross. The disciples have every reason to shrink back, unsure if they even belong in the presence of their Lord. And then, suddenly, Jesus is there. Not with words of blame, but with a message that lands like a soft blanket: 'Peace be with you.'

He doesn't ask for explanations or apologies. He shows them his wounds; proof that love survived the grave. Their fear melts into joy, because in that moment, forgiveness is not just a concept. It's a person. It's Jesus, alive and loving them as fiercely as ever.

This is not just a story for that one locked room. It's for every one of us who's ever felt ashamed, unworthy, or afraid to stand before God. Jesus says, 'Peace be with you,' not as a suggestion, but as a gift.

You don't need to be a perfect person for the Spirit to work wonders through you. The disciples were ordinary people: full of doubts, regrets, and rough edges. But when the Holy Spirit comes, those locked doors open wide.

The Spirit meets us as we are, and gives us courage, the words, and the love we need to build up the Church and the world around us. The Spirit's gifts aren't just for a chosen few. Each of us receives them in unique ways: through our personalities, our strengths, even our weaknesses.

Some of us build up the body of Christ with patience, others with kindness or faithfulness, still others with gentleness or self-control. These are the fruits of the Holy Spirit, growing quietly within us.

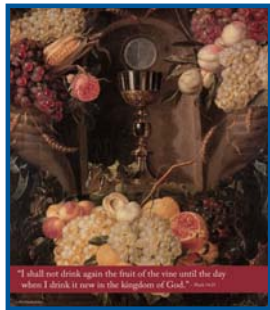

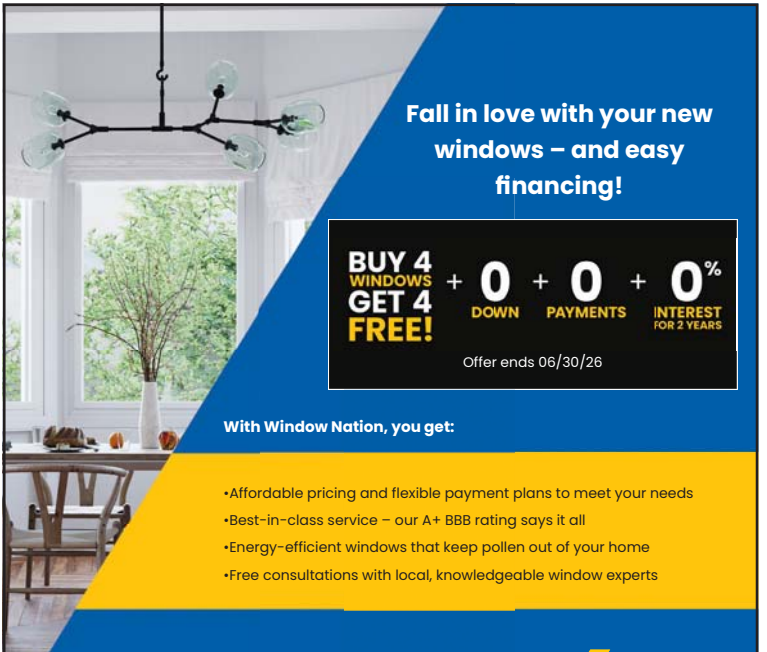
