GOSPEL**A Reading from The Gospel according to Matthew****Matthew 13:24-43**

Jesus proposed another parable to the crowds, saying: "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds all through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well. The slaves of the householder came to him and said, 'Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? Where have the weeds come from?' He answered, 'An enemy has done this. 'His slaves said to him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?' He replied, 'No, if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until harvest; then at harvest time I will say to the harvesters, "First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles for burning; but gather the wheat into my barn.'"" He proposed another parable to them. "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that a person took and sowed in a field. It is the smallest of all the seeds, yet when full-grown it is the largest of plants. It becomes a large bush, and the 'birds of the sky come and dwell in its branches.'" He spoke to them another parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed with three measures of wheat flour until the whole batch was leavened." All these things Jesus spoke to the crowds in parables. He spoke to them only in parables, to fulfill what had been said through the prophet: I will open my mouth in parables, I will announce what has lain hidden from the foundation of the world. Then, dismissing the crowds, he went into the house. His disciples approached him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds in the field." He said in reply, "He who sows good seed is the Son of Man, the field is the world, the good seed the children of the kingdom. The weeds are the children of the evil one, and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels. Just as weeds are collected and burned up with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will collect out of his kingdom all who cause others to sin and all evildoers. They will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Whoever has ears ought to hear."

Gospel of Matthew

We are all familiar with weeds in our gardens. We have a tendency to root them out immediately. However, sometimes the weeds are so close to the shrub or flower that to take out the weed risks disturbing the plant. We sometimes have to let the weeds be for the sake of the plant. We are also aware in recent times that the flowers which weeds generate can be great pollinators for our bees. We are now being told not to be rooting out our dandelions so quickly and ruthlessly. Weeds are making a comeback! In the parable that Jesus speaks in today's gospel reading, the servants of the landowner wanted to pull up the weeds that had appeared among the wheat. However, the landowner himself was a more patient man. He was aware that pulling up the weeds could pull up some wheat as well and he advised letting both weed and wheat grow until harvest time, and then they could be separated. There is always a deeper meaning to Jesus parables. He wasn't primarily talking about gardens or fields of wheat. After all, he began the parable with the words, the kingdom of God may be compared to... Jesus was really talking about God and how God relates to us. He is suggesting that God can be patient with our weaknesses because God recognizes that they are often closely aligned with our strengths.

An angry person may have a passion for justice; a lazy person may be a great listener; an overly anxious person may be very dutiful and conscientious. God recognizes that we are all a mixture of wheat and weed, of good and evil, of strength and weakness and he is patient with our mixture. We need to be patient too, with ourselves and with others. In striving after a perfect garden, a gardener risks doing harm as well as good. In striving too hard to make ourselves perfect or, more worryingly still, to make others perfect, we risk doing as much harm as good. We need to learn to live with the mixture we and others are, while celebrating and working to enhance all that is good there.

Points To Ponder

The picture in the parable this Sunday would be familiar to a Palestinian audience. A weed called the bearded darnel was one of the curses a farmer had to endure. In the early stages darnel so closely resembled wheat that it was impossible to distinguish one from the other. Both must be left to grow until the harvest time. In ancient times, sowing seeds among a growing crop was a criminal act. Even to this day in India, one of the direst threats which someone can make to an enemy is I will sow bad seed in your field.

There is always the temptation within a community for it to become a Church of the pure, a Church of the elite. The parable of the darnel presupposes such a temptation. "Do you want us to go and weed out the darnel?" 'No' said Jesus, 'because when you weed out the darnel you might pull up the wheat with it'. It is quite clear that Jesus is interested above all in saving the good grain. He wants to give the wheat every possible chance. In this life nobody can pretend to adopt that attitude that divides everything into two distinct categories; good and evil, truth and error. Heresy itself can have its grain of truth and the true teaching can contain traces of error. As Gerard McGinty once wrote 'It is possible to sense the presence of an angel and yet scent the devil'. We must practice the difficult art of discernment - a question of uniting two apparently contradictory attitudes - wanting to be the wheat and at the same time taking a stand against the 'world' and its desires.

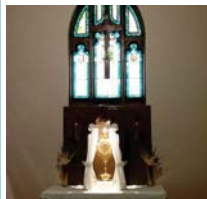

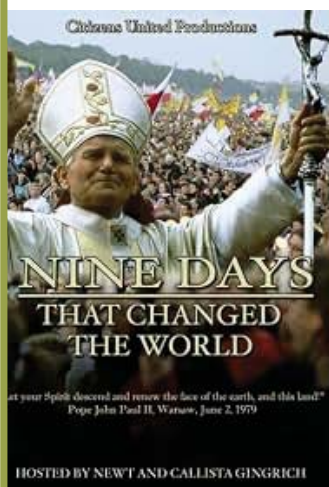
Congratulations!

Saint Mary Magdalene ***Day: July 22***

Mary, from Magdala in Galilee, was a disciple of Jesus who used her resources, or wealth, to help support him and his followers.

The Gospel of Luke identifies Mary as the woman from whom Jesus cast out seven demons. The Gospels record that she was present at his crucifixion and burial. In all four Gospels, Mary was the first witness to the Resurrection and carried that news to the others. Because of this, St. Augustine called her "apostola apostolorum," the apostle to the apostles.

On June 3, 2016, Pope Francis raised her liturgical observance from a memorial to a feast the same rank as the observances accorded to the apostles.

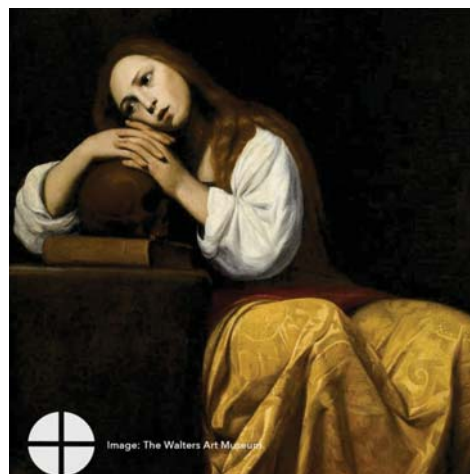

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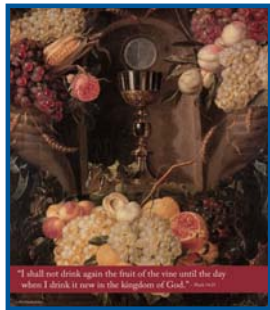

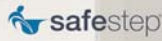
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
