Gospel of Matthew

Many of us have wonderful memories of our grandparents. Maybe we recall a celebration or family tradition, or perhaps simply their presence in our lives. We might have a keepsake that reminds us of them, of the times we shared with them one-on-one, and of their love for us. We treasure their stories and advice. These things remind us of what we have received - and continue to receive - from them.

One thing we receive from them is perspective in the here and now. We live in turbulent times. We can focus so much on our current circumstances that we give them an outsized importance and perhaps think that we are alone in facing our challenges. Our grandparents and the elderly put things in perspective and teach us that we are not alone. They remind us that there have been difficulties in the past - often greater than our current difficulties - and that many have gone before us and have faced similar struggles. They themselves struggled, suffered setbacks and sorrows, but still found much joy in their lives. By looking back and reflecting, we can see that they are able to offer us unparalleled advice and perspective. The elderly also pass on to us the Church's faith and traditions. This inheritance gives us strength in present trials and hope for the future. Many current ideas and ideologies compete for our attention. But they are passing. Our grandparents and the elderly give us the enduring truths that have built up our families and our Church. They teach us the importance of our faith for strengthening us in our difficulties and preparing us for the future. That is why I am always moved when children choose a grandparent to be their Confirmation sponsor. Seeking the wisdom of the elderly is a sign of maturity!

The World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly is an opportunity to give. Since they have given us so much, we should give back to them. What we have to give to them is both simple and powerful: time, attention and love.

Points To Ponder

A rather unusual sower goes out to sow, but does not care where the seed falls. He throws the seeds even where it is unlikely they will bear fruit: on the path, on the rocks, among the thorns. This attitude surprises the listener and induces him to ask: how come? We are used to calculating things - and at times it is necessary - but this does not apply in love! The way in which this 'wasteful' sower throws the seed is an image of the way God loves us. Indeed, it is true that the destiny of the seed depends also on the way in which the earth welcomes it and the situation in which it finds itself, but first and foremost in this parable Jesus tells us that God throws the seed of his Word on all kinds of soil, that is, in any situation of ours: at times we are more superficial and distracted, at times we let ourselves get carried away by enthusiasm, sometimes we are burdened by life's worries, but there are also times when we are willing and welcoming. God is confident and hopes that sooner or later the seed will blossom. This is how he loves us: he does not wait for us to become the best soil, but he always generously gives us his word. Perhaps by seeing that he trusts us, the desire to be better soil will be kindled in us. This IS hope, founded on the rock of God's generosity and mercy.

Saint Ignatius of Loyola

Day: July 31

Born in his family's ancestral Basque castle, Inigo Lopez de Loyola was a page in Castile and a soldier wounded in battle before he experienced a personal conversion that has had profound consequences for the church ever since. While convalescing, he read about Christ and the saints, made a long retreat at Manresa and journeyed to Jerusalem. He studied for 10 years in Barcelona and Paris, where he became Ignatius and was the center of a group of like-minded men. They founded the Society of Jesus, or Jesuits, to be active missionaries and meet the challenges of the Reformation. Ignatius, superior general of the new order, also wrote "Spiritual Exercises," which is still a popular guide. He is the patron saint of retreats and soldiers.



"Our Jesuit coat of arms is a monogram bearing the acronym of 'Jesus Hominum Salvator'...But this coat of arms constantly reminds us of a reality we must never forget: the centrality of Christ, for each one of us and for the whole Society which St Ignatius wanted to call, precisely, 'of Jesus' to indicate its point of reference.. Because there is always a temptation to think that we are at the center; and when a Jesuit puts himself and not Christ at the center he errs." - Pope Francis, homily, July 31, 2013
