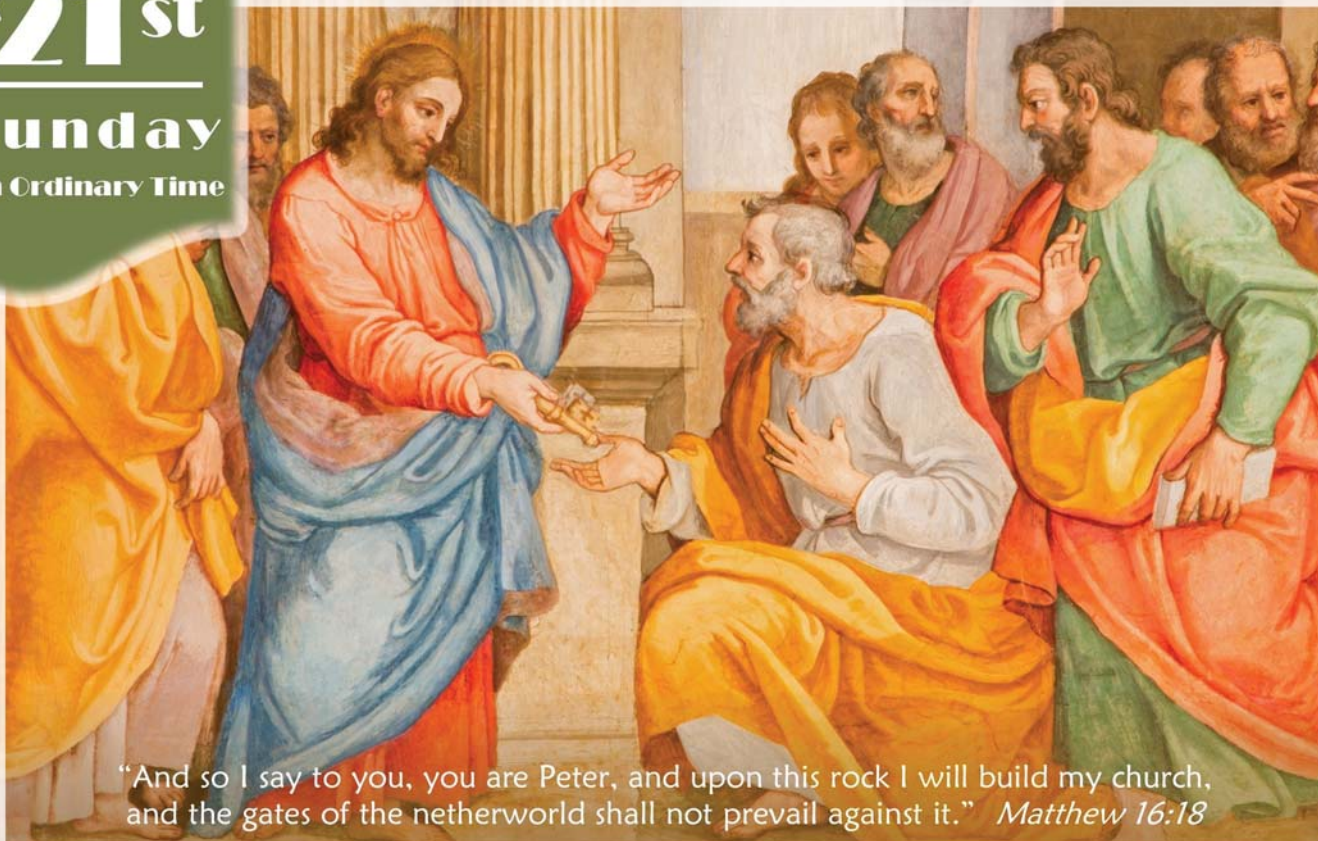

The Gospel of the Lord.

Gospel of Matthew

This Sunday's Gospel takes us back to a key juncture along Jesus' journey with his disciples: the moment in which he wants to assess the extent of their faith in him. First, he wants to know what the people think of him. Then he asks the disciples the question closest to his heart: 'But who do you say that I am?' (v. 15). And with that 'but' Jesus firmly separates the Apostles from the multitudes, as if to say: but you, who are with me every day and know me personally, what more have you understood? The Master expects from his own a lofty response different from that of public opinion. And indeed, such an answer gushes forth from the heart of Simon, called Peter: 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God' (v. 16). And from this answer, Jesus understands that, thanks to the faith given by the Father, there is a solid foundation upon which he can build his community, his Church. With us too, today, Jesus wants to continue building his Church, this house with solid foundations but where cracks are not lacking, and which is in constant need of repair. The Church always needs to be reformed, repaired. We certainly do not feel like rocks, but only like small stones. However, in Jesus' hands the smallest stone becomes precious, because he picks it up, gazes at it with great tenderness, fashions it with his Spirit, and positions it in the right place that he had always had in mind and where it can be more useful to the whole structure. Each of us is a small stone, but in Jesus' hands participates in the building of the Church. And all of us are rendered 'living stones' because when Jesus takes his stone in hand, he makes it his own; he infuses it with life, full of life, full of life from the Holy Spirit, full of life from his love. And thus we have a place and a mission in the Church: she is a community of life, made up of very many stones, all different, which form a single edifice as a sign of fraternity and communion.

Points To Ponder

On many occasions, Jesus asks his disciples not to tell anyone that he is the Son of God, the Messiah. Why might that be? The only reason I can imagine is that he's saying every one of us has to come to that knowledge for ourselves. We can't let someone else do our spiritual homework for us, but many of us do. We Catholics let the pope, bishops, and priests give us all the answers and then we just parrot them back. Has there been any experience of it ourselves? Often, the answer is 'usually not.' Many Christians believe what we're supposed to believe. But here Jesus says, 'Who do you say that I am?' What have you experienced? What have you personally discovered? What knowledge do you have?

This passage is most often used to preach the primacy of the papacy since Jesus tells Peter, 'You are the rock upon which I will build my church.' That's true, but a couple chapters later Jesus says the identical thing to the whole community: 'Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven. What you loose on earth, will be loosed in heaven' (Matthew 18:18). Jesus is not only talking about the pope; he's talking about the people of God, all of us. Peter as the symbolic leader has to do it first, but then we all participate in passing on the message.

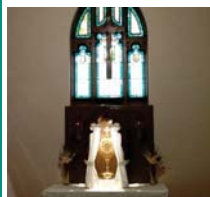

Saint Bartholomew the Apostle

Feast Day: August 24



The apostle Bartholomew (also known as Nathaniel) was born at Cana and brought by the Apostle Philip to meet Jesus. Nothing further is known for certain. Eusebius speaks of him in India, but the Roman Martyrology has him martyred in Armenia, skinned alive according to the Persian custom. He is thus often shown holding a knife with which he was martyred.

This stained glass window of the apostle is by Sir Ninian Comper, and it is in Downside Abbey in Somerset, England.



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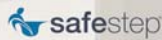
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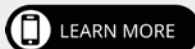
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
