A Story That Reminded Us Why We Do What We Do

This month, we had the privilege of supporting **Helen Ávila**, a young girl with cerebral palsy whose story deeply touched our entire team.

Thanks to the donations sent by our director, Kathleen Price, we were able to provide Helen with a specialized wheelchair designed to give her the proper support her body requires.

Until then, Helen had been using a standard wheelchair that was badly worn out. Instead of helping her, it caused constant pain. According to her sister, who cares for Helen while their parents work full-time to cover her medical expenses and the medications she needs every day, purchasing a specialized wheelchair was simply beyond the family's financial means because of its high cost.

Today, Helen's reality is different.

Her new wheelchair represents much more than comfort—it represents a better quality of life. She can now remain seated without experiencing the pain that once caused her to cry. Seeing the peace and happiness reflected on her family's faces reminds us that behind every donation is a life transformed.

Helen's story is not an isolated case. Every month, hundreds of families come to our foundation facing incredibly difficult circumstances. Thanks to the generosity of our donors and the dedication of our volunteers, many of them find hope, support, and the reassurance that they are not alone.

The Impact of Our Programs During July

Throughout the month of July, we continued providing our free comprehensive care programs, benefiting children, youth, and adults from different communities.

Program Results

Physical Therapy

- 55 patients served
- **380 therapy sessions** provided

Speech Therapy

- 20 patients served
- **80 therapy sessions** provided

Psychological Services

- 13 patients served
- **40 counseling sessions** provided

Academic Support Program

- 8 children participated, including 3 deaf children
- **32 educational sessions** conducted during the month

School of Love

- 9 children attended our educational program on a regular basis.
- Under the leadership of teacher **Dulce Alemán**, each day was filled with learning, inclusive activities, and opportunities for personal growth, strengthening both academic knowledge and social-emotional development.

Overall Impact

During the month of July, our foundation was able to serve **105 individuals** through the various programs we provide.

In total, **532 therapy and service sessions** were delivered—a remarkable number that represents hundreds of hours of dedication, professional care, and compassionate service. Every one of these sessions represents much more than a statistic. It represents a person regaining mobility, a child learning to communicate, a family receiving emotional support, or a student discovering new opportunities for the future.

These accomplishments are only possible because of the tireless work of our volunteers, physical therapists, psychologists, teachers, and staff members who generously give their time, knowledge, and hearts every single day.

Growth of Our Facilities

In addition to the work carried out through our programs, we continued improving our new facilities throughout the month.

Thanks to the continued support of Kathleen Price, we are making steady progress on the construction of a new storage building that will allow us to safely organize and store the donations we receive for the families we serve.

At the same time, work continues on our greenhouse project, an initiative that will contribute to the long-term development of the foundation while creating new opportunities for sustainability in the future.

These projects have required continuous effort, with at least two days each week dedicated exclusively to construction and organizing these new spaces, always with the goal of growing so we can serve even more families.

Final Reflection

At **Mission of Love Guatemala**, the work never stops. Every day brings new challenges, new needs, and new opportunities to transform lives.

Although the days are often long and the challenges can seem overwhelming, we remain convinced that every effort is worthwhile when we witness a child's smile, a mother's peace of mind, or the gratitude of a family receiving the help they so desperately needed.
