# From the desk of Fr. John ...

On Saturday, the sixth of September, at 11am our own Jose R. Capo will be ordained a permanent deacon by Bishop Barbarito. We congratulate Jose and promise him our prayers as he assumes this vital ministry in the Church. He and Deacon Eddie Ortiz provide tremendous service to Saint Jude and are a blessing to us all. Jose completed a five-year formation program leading to his Ordination. We are proud of him and thank him, and Deacon Eddie, for answering the Lord's call to the permanent diaconate.

We are used to having transitional deacons here—men in their last year of studies at the Seminary who are preparing for ordination to the priesthood. This is a good time to explain a bit about the permanent diaconate. Permanent deacons serve as "living icons of Christ the Servant" within the Church assisting bishops and priests in various ways. Deacons proclaim the Gospel, preach and teach. They assist at Mass, baptize, prepare couples for marriage, witness marriages and preside at wake/funeral services. Deacons have a special role in the ministry of charity—serving the poor, sick and marginalized. Permanent deacons work closely with the pastor and parochial vicar and the other members of the pastoral team. As the name implies, permanent deacons remain deacons throughout their lives.

I want to wish everyone, especially the employees of the Church and School, a restful Labor Day weekend. Our staff is the best—they all go above and beyond in trying to meet the needs of the parishioners. I feel blessed to work with such generous people who are always ready to go the extra mile without complaining! Not one employee has every said no to a request for assistance.

I hope you have marked your calendar and plan on attending our Bingo, Burgers and Brew event on September 6<sup>th</sup>. We will open the doors to Mount Carmel Hall at 6pm. The evening is always enjoyable—prizes are awarded and a good time is had by all! Please go on line to purchase your tickets—act now before the event sells out.

We received a request from the Diocese to take up a special collection to assist the humanitarian aid efforts in Gaza. #### LABOR DAY

The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us of this sacred rhythm: "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are to refrain from engaging in work or activities that hinder the worship owed to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, the performance of the works of mercy, and the appropriate relaxation of mind and body." (CCC, 2185)

**Labor Day** offers a moment to pause and consider how we honor the Sabbath and whether we give ourselves and our families the rest necessary to serve God and our neighbor more fully. As Catholics, **Labor Day** is a time to reflect on the deeper significance of work in our lives. It is a day to thank God for the gift of labor, to honor those who contribute to society through their work, and to remember the Church's teachings on the dignity and rights of workers.






