

St. Jude received several generous dountions in 2024-2025 that helped to make up the short fall in this years offeratory. These dountions allowed the church to help support community outreach programs, build the adoration chapel, and cover our operating expenses. A large percentage of St. Jude's expense are related to parish repair and maintenance, property insurance, employee salaries including taxes and benefits.

2025-2026 financial challenges include: meeting the 293,000 DSA goal, the replacement of the priory roof and the general maintenance of the church and grounds.

With the continued support of the 40th Anniversary Campaign the renovation of the Sacristy will be completed and a new electric sign at the church entrance on Toledo Road.
