



Encountering Jesus Together: A First Communion Family Retreat



Last Saturday, our Religious Education First Communion students gathered with their parents for our very first, **First Holy Communion Family Retreat**. Families gathered for a special morning focused on encountering Jesus together through prayer, reflection, and hands-on activities.

To begin the retreat, families worked together to create a mural collage celebrating our parish as the Body of Christ. Each family designed and decorated a picture representing their family and added it to a large mural surrounding an image of Jesus with the words, **“Our Parish Family Is the Body of Christ.”** The finished mural was a beautiful reminder that together we form one family - our church family - where we meet Jesus, pray together, learn about God, and grow in love as one body.


Parents and children then explored how throughout Scripture, God used food in miracles to care for people. He gave manna to the Israelites, turned water into wine at Cana, fed thousands with a few loaves and fish, and at the Last Supper, he gave us his Body and Blood - **Jesus the Bread of Life**. After reflecting on these miracles, the children created their own bread dough creations. These culinary masterpieces were baked and sent home to be enjoyed with their families. I believe we may have a few up-and-coming pastry chefs in our midst!

Fr. John then shepherded the children from Mt. Carmel Hall to the church for a guided tour, stopping along the way to highlight some of the beautiful statues that grace our campus. Inside the church, the children visited sacred spaces and learned about the vessels, objects, and vestments used during Mass.

The retreat concluded with a beautiful time of **Eucharistic Adoration**. Fr. John placed the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance and explained how incense is used during Adoration as a symbol of our prayers rising to heaven. The children were invited to come forward and place pieces of incense resin onto the coals, offering their prayers to God. It was a deeply moving experience that I couldn't resist being a part of. As I added a few pieces of incense myself, I prayed for all of our First Communion children and their parents and I thanked God for the amazing ways He continues to reveal Himself to me. I left the church smelling of incense and feeling incredibly blessed.

I invite you, our parish family, to keep these children and their families in your prayers. We ask that God continue to guide them as they prepare to receive the sacrament of First Holy Communion.
