





Catholic Parish Life as Salt and Light

Jesus tells His disciples, "You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world." These words describe individual Christians, but they can also describe the life of the parish as a whole.



A Catholic parish is salt when it preserves and strengthens faith in a world that often forgets God. Through the celebration of the Eucharist, the teaching of the Church, and the support of one another in prayer and service, the parish adds "flavor" to daily life - helping families live with hope, mercy, and truth. When a parish remains rooted in Christ, it gives witness that faith matters and transforms how we love and serve.

A parish is also light, visible to the community like "*a city set on a mountain*." The parish shines when its good works are seen: feeding the hungry, visiting the sick, welcoming the stranger, forming children in faith, and gathering joyfully around the altar. These acts are not meant to draw attention to ourselves, but to point others to God, just as Jesus says: "*that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father.*"

When parish life is centered on Christ - especially in the Eucharist - it cannot be hidden. United in worship and sent out in service, the parish becomes salt that gives life and light that leads others to God. Here's a challenge for the week. As a family (or as an individual), choose one way to be **salt** and one way to be **light** this week. Here are a few examples:

Be Salt: Add kindness where it's needed. Encourage someone who is struggling, forgive a small hurt, or help at home without being asked.

Be Light: Let your faith be seen. Pray together before a meal, reach out to someone who is lonely, or do a quiet act of service for a neighbor.

At the end of the week, take a moment to reflect or talk together as a family: Where did you bring God's love into the world? How did your actions help others see Jesus? Who helped you see God's love this week, and how?

Filled with the grace of the Eucharist, may we be beacons of Jesus' love, bringing His light to everyone we meet.


These words are taken from St. Augustine's exposition on Psalm 127, where he explains that, although we Christians are many, in the one Christ we are one.
