## **OUR MISSION**

We are a people of diverse backgrounds and ethnic origins united by God, formed by the Gospels, strengthened by the Sacraments and the teachings of the Catholic Church. ### **IMPACT**

This report highlights the collective impact of our church's outreach programs, ministry groups, parish members, volunteers and our school initiatives over the past year. It reflects our commitment to serving our community, nurturing faith, and providing a welcoming and supportive environment for all. We are grateful for the dedication of our volunteers, the generosity of our donors, and the unwavering spirit of our community.

## CHURCH PROGRAMS

#### **Ministry Groups**

St. Jude currently hosts many active ministry groups that gather weekly in Mt. Carmel Hall, The Gathering Place, and the church itself. Each ministry addresses various needs within our community.

#### **Food Drive:**

- The Hunger Program collected 1000 grocery bags filled with non-perishable goods to support multiple food pantries in the area. Donations were sent to local and international charities to feed the hungry.
- Knights of Columbus collected 26,000 pounds of food for Boca Helping Hands.
- Parish Thanksgiving Box Brigade collected 100 bags of food.

Our ministry food drive continues to be a vital resource for individuals and families facing food insecurity. We have seen many lives transformed through these efforts, and we are committed to continuing this important work.

#### Child Welfare Nonprofit Support :

- Sponsored 100 underserved students to attend summer camp at Campo Allegre.
- Distributed 575 Christmas gifts to children through our Holiday Giving Tree.
- Donated 200 tickets for low-income families to enjoy our popular events: Fall Festival, Breakfast with Santa and Easter Breakfast with the Bunny.
- Organized a Baby Shower, gathering over 300 essential baby items.



#### **Community Outreach:**

- In July, the Christ Child Society group successfully established a new Little Library at Place of Hope.
- The American Heritage Girl Scouts collected 63 boxes for Operation Christmas in partnership with Samaritan's Purse.
   Additionally, they organized a drive for personal healthcare supplies benefiting the Veterans Association.
- Provided financial assistance to families facing economic difficulties.



- · Rectory home roof repair.



#### **School Facility Improvements:**

At Saint Jude Catholic School, we believe our physical spaces should reflect our mission, values, and vibrant history. This summer, we embarked on a long-anticipated transformation of our middle school facility— a project born from thoughtful planning, creative vision, and a desire to inspire our students as they grow in faith and knowledge.


From the start, we knew we needed some repairs to our roof and interior building. Once that was completed we wanted something more than just a plain painted renovation. We envisioned a space that would speak to the heart of who we are. Drawing inspiration from a previous project by a talented artist, we invited Paul O'Neill to collaborate with us, but this time, with a focus on the story of Saint Jude and the legacy of our school. We selected custom images that reflected our history and our patron saint, ensuring the final result would be deeply personal and meaningful to our community.


To bring this vision to life, we began by completely resurfacing the atrium space. The area was handed over to Gantt Construction for a full refresh. The walls were stripped of carpet and dated décor, the furniture removed, and once their expert work was complete, the artist stepped in — and in just two and a half weeks, transformed the space with stunning artwork that brings our story to life through the lives of the saints.

New blue lockers and sleek baseboards were the final touches, adding a sense of order and freshness to the area. The result is a bright, inspiring, and deeply spiritual space that celebrates our past and looks toward our future.

We are over the moon with the transformation and cannot wait to welcome our students back to school. As they enter this renewed space, we hope they feel the power of community, the beauty of our faith, and the excitement of a new year filled with hope.


# SUMMER SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS
