



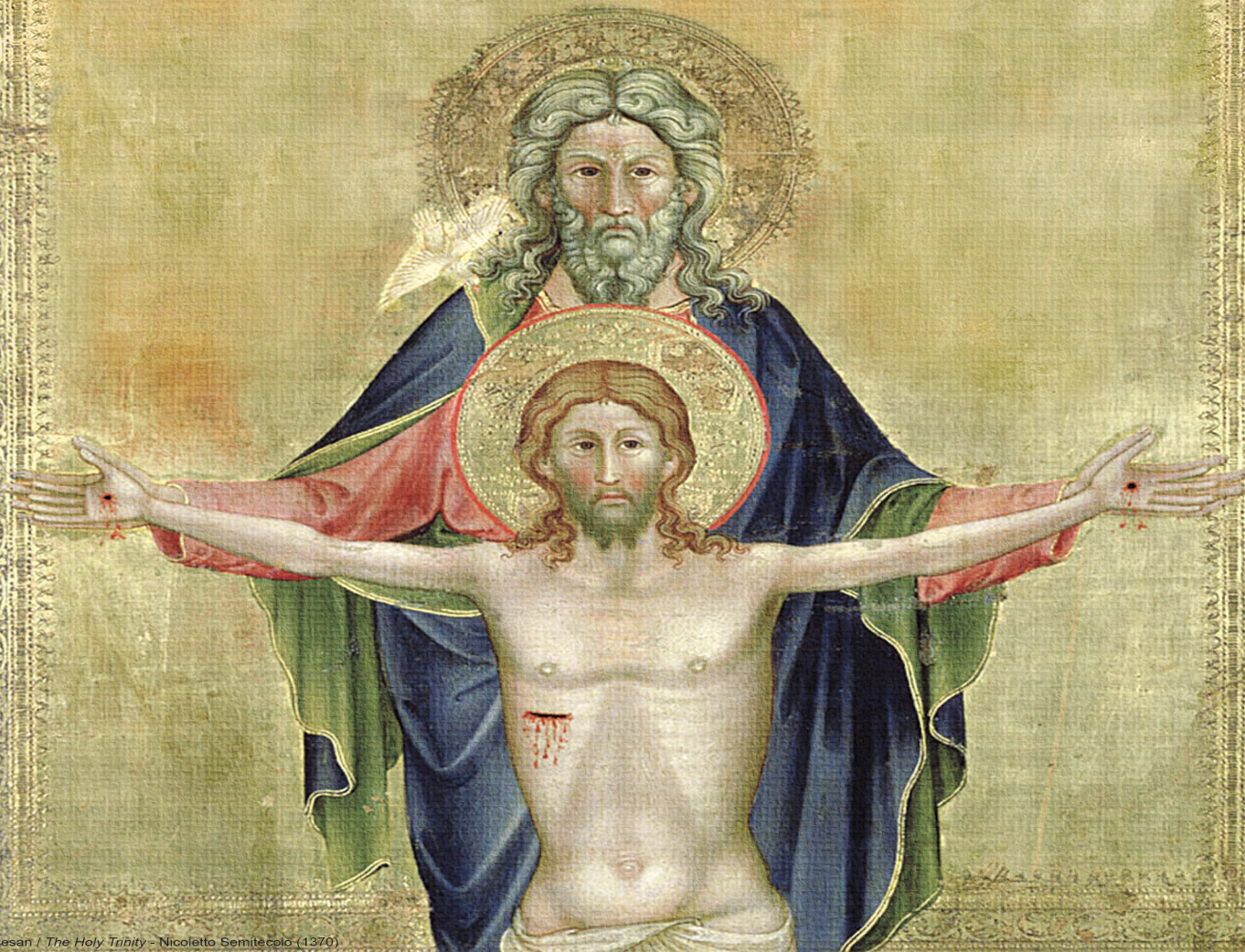

**Sacraments**

**BAPTISM** Parents having their First Child baptized must complete a baptismal preparation class. Currently we are only scheduling private Baptisms on Saturdays and Sunday. Please contact the Parish Office to make arrangements and to discuss available dates.

**MARRIAGE** Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Marriage preparation classes are required to be completed before the Sacrament of Marriage can be celebrated. A person or their family must be registered parishioners for a minimum of 6 months before contacting us about a wedding date. This is done to ensure that adequate time is allowed for preparation. We do not have weddings on Sundays. Please contact the Parish Office before making wedding arrangements.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK** Please call our emergency line to schedule a time with Father.

**RECONCILIATION**St. Rose: Saturday at 3:15PM or by appointment.St. Patrick: After any scheduled Mass or by appointment.

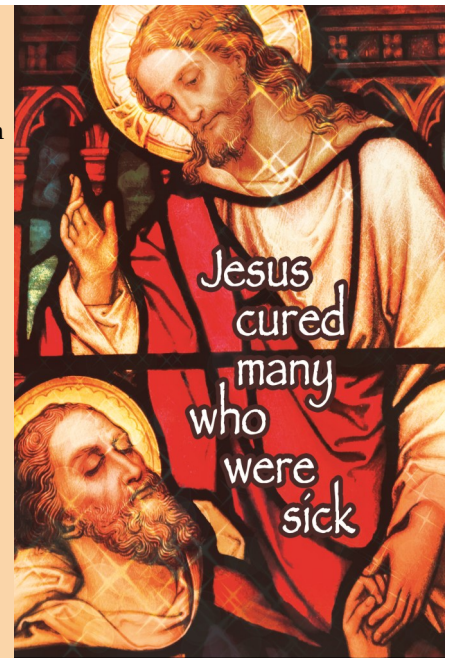

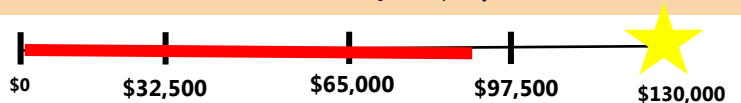

**MASS ETIQUETTE****APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR DURING MASS**

1. **FAST.** Do not eat any food for one hour before mass starts. Drinking water is allowed.
2. **COME EARLY.** Allow for 5-10 minutes of meditation before Mass.
3. **DRESS PROPERLY.** Show decency in God's house. Gentlemen, please remove your hats.
4. **USE HOLY WATER.** Bless yourself in the sign of the cross, as a sign of your baptism, as you enter and leave the church.
5. **DO NOT EAT, CHEW OR DRINK.** The church is a place of prayer and reflection.
6. **NO PHONES.** Silence or turn off your mobile phones.
7. **GENUFLECT.** Kneel towards the tabernacle before sitting.
8. **BE SILENT.** Avoid talking.
9. **LET OTHERS SIT.** Allow others to sit in your pew.
10. **PARTICIPATE.** Sing, respond, listen and pray.
11. **BE CONSIDERATE.** Respect personal spaces.
12. **STAY UNTIL MASS ENDS.** Do not leave before the final blessing.

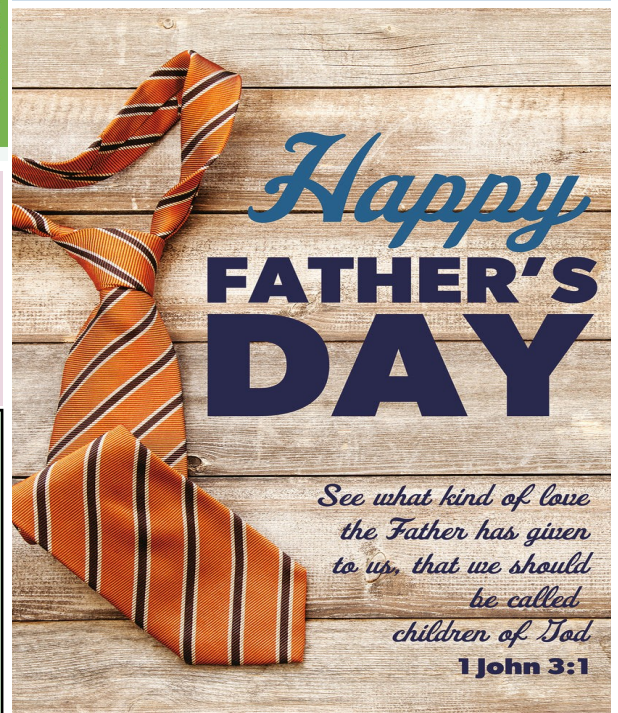
