

## Mixed Animal Veterinary Surgeon

Morven Veterinary Practice in Aberdeenshire is a 100% independent, truly mixed practice in the beautiful eastern highlands of Scotland, and we are looking for a mixed vet to join our team.

- Genuinely mixed Practice (70% small, 20% farm, 10% equine)
  - 2 site
  - Full time permanent position.

We are ideally looking for 1-2 years experience, although it is more important we find the right candidate to compliment our existing vets. We are well suited to a recent graduate with lots of friendly support - currently 7 vets (6 FTE), 3 of which are VetGDP advisors, and a team of qualified nurses. Salary commensurate with experience (benchmarked against SPVS salary survey).

Our two-site practice in Aberdeenshire is centred on our main clinic in the historic town of Alford (home of the Aberdeen Angus), 35mins from Aberdeen airport, and with easy access to Aberdeen city. We also have a consulting practice in the scenic tourist hotspot of Ballater in the Royal Deeside region of Cairngorms national park.

We are proud to offer our own out of hours service for our clients and our on-calls generally aren't too busy, but with normal seasonal variation. The on-call rota is 1:4 which is balanced with time off in lieu during the week, meaning a 4 week rolling rota with a 4 day working week.

We are happy to provide formal on-call back-up support depending on the candidate, but informally we are a collaborative team and are always happy to back each other up as needed.

Sole charge consulting is rarely needed and will only be asked of you once you feel truly ready for it.

Our days generally consist of small animal consulting (15min appointments) 9-11am, 11:30-12:30pm, 2-3:30pm and 4-6pm (never the same vet for all 4 blocks), on average 4-5 small animal surgeries/procedures, and approximately 2-3 large animal calls through the day divided fairly across the team, with at least 1 surgery and 1 large animal day each week.
