

THE SCHOOL OF BALLET

The School of Ballet at Dance It Forward / Greater York Dance sets the stage for the entire school. We are an American Academy of Ballet Certified School where students receive the finest training from faculty who have specific knowledge of our syllabus, philosophy and legacy. It is both our privilege and our responsibility to joyfully pass on the ballet traditions of classical ballet. Under the guidance of our instructors, students learn new positions and movements – repeating and refining them until each becomes part of the body's muscle memory. Students are encouraged to take lower level classes in addition to their own level to reinforce their strength and understanding of technique and to broaden their knowledge and enhance versatility. The technique taught is based on the Russian, Italian and French schools. Like the alphabet, every movement is learned separately, then woven together into combinations of movements and finally into ballet pieces.

All students move at different rates and unlike grades in school, some students spend more time in a level than others while the foundation of their technique develops. When the student has learned the technique appropriate to a level, the student is then moved on to the next level. Advancement is based on ability rather than by age. Those pursuing pointe need to take a minimum of 3 classes per week to gain strength and maintain overall fitness in order to prevent injury. Pointe is simply an extension of ballet training, and it is decided by faculty when a student is ready, never before age 9. All Ballet Program, Pre-professional and School of Early Childhood dancers (from age 4) may audition to perform in the Nutcracker Ballet. Dancers who wish to have a full pre-professional ballet experience should consider membership into the Midstate Ballet. The Midstate Ballet provides both technical and performance training to aspiring dancers. Most youth ballet dancers are college-bound or wish to pursue professional careers. Performance Training through Midstate Ballet develops the versatility in dancers that is needed to excel at leading universities and with professional choreographers and companies.

Our programs have a proven record of success as our dancers currently are performing as professionals all over the world. Students use the professional atmosphere in which to grow and as they discover themselves, they are assisted in making career choices whether it be to dance or to explore the many other opportunities available to them in college or otherwise.

Company Training


The company training program, open to dancers from age 6, is the first step for the blossoming dancer in a pre-professional training environment. Although most dancers take class 3-4 days per week, there are no attendance requirements. Once the determination is made that a student has the physical capability to learn technique and the student has the needed intellectual and emotional ability to commit to the program, the dancer begins to progress through the levels. Summer study is required. Students with previous training should contact us for a placement class.

Our Ballet Program may commence at age 3. The School of Early Childhood Storybook Pre-Ballet & Primary Ballet classes are the first steps entering into the beautiful world of ballet for students ages 3-6.

Performance Awards of the American Academy of Ballet

Faculty teaches both technique and artistry using the Performance Awards variations and technical studies. Each level of the Performance Awards has a set of exercises and variations that the students will learn. Students will present in front of an adjudicator from the American Academy of Ballet complete with awards. Preparation and adjudication is typically held in the Summer.

THE SCHOOL OF COMMERCIAL DANCE

Students in the School of Commercial Dance explore movement while enjoying incredible music in classes structured to enhance athleticism that can't be rivaled in any gym. Students will also gain confidence that can enrich their overall well-being and nourish their soul. Classes are held regularly in Hip Hop, Jazz/Tap, Contemporary, Musical Theatre, Acro, and Pom Squad & Cheer. Students receive an award each season following the June Show. GYD Crews Performing Company & Musical Theatre Classes are open to all interested dancers enrolled in at least one other class. Most classes in the School of Commercial Dance are Performance Classes and will perform in upcoming performances. We are NOT a competition school. We value our dancers way much more than that!

Middle and High schoolers join together for a weekly meeting/rehearsal; NHSDA uniform required. The National Honor Society for Dance ArtsTM (NHSDA) is a program of the National Dance Education Organization, created to recognize outstanding artistic merit, leadership, and academic achievement in students studying dance in public and private schools in K-12 education, dance studios, cultural/community centers, performing arts organizations, and post-secondary education. The NHSDA offers three levels of induction: The Junior Program for grades 6-8, The Secondary Program for grades 9-12, and The Collegiate Program for students in college or university dance programs. Establishing an NHSDA chapter is one very important way that we honor our students and help advance the field of dance education. This class is for all Middle School & High School dancers who wish to be members of the National Honor Society for Dance Arts and participate in a company. *One ballet class/week required to perform with NHSDA Ensemble.

Online Enrollment

Your first month's payment must be received to guarantee your enrollment. Credit/Debit Card (4% fee) or ACH from your bank account (1% fee) is required to be on file. If you wish to write a check and not have the autopay kick in, simply write a check by the 20th of each month in advance. If you pay late, a late payment fee of \$15 will be added to your account on the 15th of the month. Returned Check Fee & Failed Credit Card Fee – \$25.

If you need assistance to pay for dance lessons, please ask about our financial assistance application (due by September 1 of each season). The Parents Committee also makes available individual fundraisers per season for students to earn credits towards trips, dues, etc.
