

Glass Cleaning & Maintenance Guidelines

To preserve the beauty and functionality of your glass surfaces, we recommend the following cleaning and maintenance practices:

Routine Cleaning

For daily or light cleaning, a feather duster is ideal to remove surface dust and maintain a clean appearance.

Thorough Cleaning

If deeper cleaning is needed, follow these recommended materials and methods:

Approved Materials:

- A soft, lint-free cloth (avoid coarse paper towels or brown paper, which may scratch the surface)
- A non-abrasive, ammonia-free glass cleaner

Cleaning Method:

- 1. Lightly spray the cleaning solution onto the cloth never directly onto the glass.
- 2. Gently dab the cloth on the glass surface to lift away dust and lint.
- 3. For areas with heavier soil or smudges, use a soft, circular motion.
- 4. Clean all accessible areas of the glass thoroughly.

Important Notes:

- Do not use automatic cleaning equipment or tools intended for other flooring surfaces (such as mops and traditional soaps), as these may damage or degrade the glass.
- Avoid abrasive materials, harsh chemicals, or ammonia-based solutions, which can compromise the glass finish.

Ongoing Maintenance

Just like any functional material, glass benefits greatly from a consistent maintenance program. In addition to regular cleaning, we recommend:

- Annual inspections of both the glass and all related components.
- Close review of surrounding materials, including grouts, adhesives, fasteners, and hardware.
- Special attention to the silicone sealant used in installation any cracking, gaps, or imperfections should be addressed and replaced immediately..
