



2026 President's Challenge

To strengthen and encourage promotion of the Cleveland Bay Horse through the show ring, this year's President, Muick Wood, will present a series of participation awards at the 2026 AGM. These awards are open to all fully paid-up members of the Society who compete in the pure or part bred sections of Shows that hold Cleveland Bay classes.

Based on the published CBHS Show Diary, and calculated on a points system, members may compete for the following:

Available Awards (£125 each)

1. Most Shows Competed At

Open to any CBHS member who exhibits any registered pure or part-bred Cleveland Bay, owned or loaned to them, at the most shows listed as having a CB Section in the Show Diary (Tie-break rules apply).

2. Most Classes Competed In

Open to pure and part-bred registered Cleveland Bays. Any handler or rider combination from the same household may compete with any Cleveland Bay owned or loaned to them. Exhibitors who show more than one horse in a CB/PB class multiply their attendance by the number of horses they put forward (Tie-break rules apply).

3. Most CBHS Award Points Gained

Open to pure and part-bred registered Cleveland Bays.

The award will be presented to the eligible horse who receives the most points throughout the show season at shows with a CB/PB section. In-hand and ridden class points will be combined. (Tie-break rules apply)

4. Most Miles Travelled

Awarded for the greatest verified mileage to and from the shows listed in the CBHS Show Diary for the entire show season.

Mileage must be able to be evidenced using the most direct route between the same home/yard postcode and the show postcode as shown in Google Maps.

Tie-Break Rules

If two or more entrants are tied:

1. Final placings will determine the winner.
2. If still tied, the prize money will be split evenly.

General rules:

The owner is deemed to be the person(s) named in the horse's passport.

A loan agreement lodged with the CBHS is evidence of a horse loaned.
