Information from the CBHS Office

We have had several hair sample test failures in recent months resulting in repeat samples being requested. I asked the Laboratory Lead staff member if they could shed any light on why this was happening. The following was the reply which I hope you find useful going forward:-

We don't generate reports for sample failures.

However we have looked into this case further for you and the reason given is sample quality, this can be due to a number of factors such as contamination, lack of roots or just not enough hair in the sample.

For best results we advise taking the sample from the tail or shoulder, we require at least 40 good clean and dry hairs including the root.

Standard of paperwork:

Time is being wasted due to incomplete addresses/details on passport applications/membership requests. Please do not choose to complete any forms whilst running for a bus. This is what some of them look like. If I cannot read the address or the postcode is omitted then I cannot progress the paperwork without spending time looking on Royal Mail website or google maps.

Please do not print the passport application double sided. The mark up completed by your Vet has to be scanned into the passport. If this has print on the other side then the quality achieved is very poor.

A little more care in the completion of applications can save the office hours and will probably result in a quicker turn around of passports for owners.
