

Cleveland Bay Camp 2026

Lincomb Equestrian - DY13 9RB

25th - 27th September 2026

The Cleveland Bay Horse Society are pleased to invite participants to their 3rd annual Camp.

For 2026, we are meeting 10 miles North of Worcester in the Severn Valley at Lincomb Equestrian, from Friday 25th September to Sunday 27th September 2026. We are looking forward to a weekend of lessons, clinics, pleasure riding and socialising with all comers, whilst helping to raise the awareness of our breed.

Lincomb Equestrian comes highly recommended and offers 20 stables, 3 outdoor arenas with show jumps, a canter track and an extensive Cross Country course spread over 50 acres and with 8 miles of off road riding. For more details please visit www.crosscountrycourse.co.uk

The Camp is aimed at Grassroots level to boost confidence with your horse and to improve you both in a fun and stress free environment. It is open to all - CBHS members and non-members, Cleveland Bays both pure and part bred and non (aka honorary) Cleveland Bays. This includes young horses, In Hand and Novice ridden, as the Camp aims to be as inclusive as possible, stallions being the only exception. We have been fortunate enough to engage the services of the two fabulous instructors we had last year, Hazel Towers (5* eventer) and Bev Walton (equine behaviourist). They were outstanding at our previous two Camps, and we are delighted that they have agreed to do it all again!

The cost of the two day Camp is £250, and includes 2 nights stabling for your horse, including hay and straw, all the facilities and at least 2 lessons/activities including a choice from show jumping, cross country, conformation clinic, show preparation, long reining, desensitisation, flat work, pole work or any other requests. The cost also

includes meals and drinks for the whole weekend as we have access to a club house and kitchen on site.

Accommodation for humans is not included, but Lincomb offer some inexpensive options, such as glamping and cottages for an extra £50pp. There is a free camping area and lorry park (although hookups are NOT available, and you are encouraged to bring a fully charged battery). We can offer guidance to decide which is the right accommodation option for you. Coleen Benfold (07854 868910) is collating requests and deposits.

A refundable deposit of £50 (by February 28th 2026) secures your place on the Camp weekend, with the remainder (in 4/5 x £50** instalments if preferred) being due by June 15th 2026.

Places will be allocated on a strictly first come, first served basis and if the Camp is oversubscribed we will start a waiting list.
