RULES

Mare Maintenance Grant: A payment of £150 for each mare, owned by a UK resident and located in the UK, on production of a 2026 covering or AI certificate for a CBHS licenced pure-bred stallion. Grant to defray veterinary expenses, livery or other associated costs. No grant will be payable where the covering certificate relates to a RED banded mating Grassroots SPARKS report, a filly 2 years or younger, or to a mare that has not produced a foal in the last 3 years. If the mare in the 3rd or proceeding years conceives a foal, payment will be given upon receipt of a veterinary report.

NB: Where an owner (who is a UK member) has a mare on loan to another UK member for breeding purposes, the payments referred to above will be paid to the loanee (who will need to be a paid-up member residing in the UK), not the owner of the animal, and documentation should be lodged at the office for verification.
