Council have approved the following offer for Overseas Members of the Cleveland Bay Horse Society.

Pure Bred Cleveland Bays born overseas, of any age, upon receipt of completed Registration document together with hair sample. The Identification chart must be completed in accordance with the rules for Pure registration, this means the ID chart has to be completed by a veterinary surgeon which includes the vet collecting the hair sample. (We would also recommend microchipping)

Both parents must be clearly named on the Registration document.

Any applications for a pure Cleveland Bay with any white must send a photograph of all white markings.

Or

(where no Covering Certificate is available as some animals will be potentially older than a foal, and documentary evidence of acceptable proof of purchase may not be to hand)

Photographs must be submitted of the horse showing head on head shot (from the front),
full frontal including head (from the front of horse) rear of the horse (from behind the horse),
a picture of each side of the horse. Proof of purchase documentation.

Upon receipt of the correctly presented pure registration form, pure Cleveland Bays will be given **FREE** registration (inc DNA fees) provided parental verification (DNA) is confirmed by the UK Laboratory and the purebred is not in the RED area of the Sparks Sheets prepared by the Dr Dell for the CBHS.

Claimants must be Members of the CBHS.
