Please give a short biography of your personal achievements:

I live in Sandy, Utah, USA. I was born and raised in Houston, Texas and have been retired since 2016 from a career with the US Federal Government in Washington, D.C. and Utah.

As a life-long horse enthusiast, and a horse owner since 1965, I have admired Cleveland Bays from afar, mainly in the hunting field, for decades. I acquired my first part bred in 2018, a 2015 filly by Tregoyd William, who produced a  $\frac{3}{4}$  bred filly by Galveston in 2022. That filly is now being started lightly under saddle. In 2024 I also acquired a pure bred mare, who has produced a filly foal this past June.

My first job as a teenager, other than babysitting, was as a riding instructor for a day camp in Texas at age 13. Over the ensuing 60 years I have periodically, on an amateur basis, taught riding lessons and trained horses for myself and friends, while pursuing foxhunting as my main equestrian activity and also competing successfully in many English and Western disciplines, including show jumping in France. I enjoy camping in the back country of the Rocky Mountains with my horses and taking friends and visitors for rides in the West Desert of Utah to admire the roaming Mustangs. I have been competing in mounted archery in 2017, and have enjoyed that sport in the US, France, and Mongolia.

While serving on Council from 2020 to 2024, I assisted with many tasks, including the overseas stallion survey, assisting with creating a new website, updating the Articles of Association and CBHS Rules and working on Bay Window. While serving as Chair from 2021 to 2023, I also conducted Council meetings and Annual General Meetings and interfaced with DEFRA and the Charity Commission as needed.

I very strongly believe that the Cleveland Bay is a wonderful horse, and the breed is worth supporting so that it not only survives but thrives in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.
