Texas Scramble

Terms of Competition

- 1. This competition is limited to players with a WHS handicap who are members of Heworth Golf Club. Maximum handicap index is 54.0, but a maximum handicap index of 28.1 is applied
- 2. Play will be in accordance with the Rules of Golf as issued by the R&A.
- 3. It is a Texas Scramble Strokeplay played over 18 holes from the White Tees.
- 4. Teams are made of 3 or 4 players with the following handicap allowances:
 - 4 players 25%, 20%, 15% and 10% from the lowest to highest course handicap
 - 3 players 30%, 20% and 10% from the lowest to highest course handicap
- 5. Each team member drives off on every hole, and team members select which drive to use and the player of this ball places a marker before playing his next shot. This player must play as the ball lies. The other balls are then positioned using the following rules:
 - On the Putting Green: place within 6 inches, no nearer the hole
 - In parts of the General Area cut to fairway height or less: place within 6 inches, no nearer the hole
 - Elsewhere in the General Area, Penalty Areas & Bunkers: drop within 1 club length, no nearer the hole on same type of ground
 - When Preferred Lies or Lift, Clean & Replace are in operation in the whole General Area or in Bunkers: place within 6 inches, no nearer the hole on same type of ground
- 6. Failure to place a marker before the first players shot being completed will result in that player's shot counting.
- 7. This procedure continues until a ball has been holed and the gross score is recorded. Each hole is to be noted on the scorecard with all scores added together at the end of the round. The team's handicap is then deducted from the total gross to give the nett score for the round
- 8. The drive taken for each hole is also to be recorded on the scorecard so that each team member has at least the following number of drives:

- For a team of 4, each team members drive MUST be used on at least 4 holes
- For a team of 3, each team members drive MUST be used on at least 5 holes
- 9. Scorecards should be checked, signed by 2 players and returned to the Committee as soon as possible after the end of the round, following score entry into the clubhouse PSI Terminal in the bar.
- 10. A scorecard is considered returned when:
 - it is posted into the box below the score entry PSI terminal in the clubhouse
 - handed to a member of the competitions committee
- 11. In the event of a tie after 18 holes, the result shall be decided on countback based on the score for the last nine holes, last six holes, last three holes and finally the 18th hole.
- 12. If there is still a tie, then the last six holes, three holes and final hole of the first nine holes will be considered in turn.
- 13. The result of the competition is final once the competition has been closed within the Club's competition management software package.
- 14. The Terms of Competition are supplementary to the General Terms of Competition for Competitions as published on the Club website.
