FLEXIBLE

Volunteers embrace creative thinking and expect flexibility in the fluid atmosphere of a conference environment. We will extend grace.

RELIABLE

Volunteers will make this serving opportunity a priority, so we can be counted on to do what we say we're going to do, when we are asked and needed to do it. We will always show up on time, work through the entirety of our shifts and days of duty, and work hard to do an excellent job. We will take care to ensure that any sight-seeing while off-duty will not negatively impact our service commitments. From the first until the final day of our service in Johannesburg, we will not expect to be able to do any other school or professional work. We commit to excellent and generous communication, including honoring others' time by responding in a timely manner when contacted.

NEUTRAL

Volunteers will avoid treating others with undue favoritism or disfavoritism for any reason, including race, tribe, gender, age, region, nationality, or opinion. We will avoid any public expression of an opinion on any matter while it is still pending before the General Conference for a final decision, on social media and in other public spaces. This includes refraining from publicly promoting or opposing nominees for particular offices.

KIND

Because our ethos in the Global Methodist Church is grounded in grace, we strive to cultivate a culture of honor that emphasizes cooperation and partnership. That will be reflected in conversations on the phone and in person, at all times. We will treat all people with consistent Golden-Rule respect, with a positive attitude.
