#### **Itinerary:**

September 6: Fly to Hoedspruit. Upon arrival transfer to your lodge for check in and dinner. (D)

September 7: Full Day Kruger Safari game drive. (B, L, D)

September 8: Enjoy a visit to the Moholoholo Wildlife Rehabilitation Center or to the Hoedspruit Endangered Species Center this morning. This afternoon, visit the Panorama Route. This is one of the most beautiful parts of South Africa connecting the Lowveld and the amazing geological features of the Mpumalanga Drakensberg. Some highlights include the Blyde River Canyon Reserve, breathtaking waterfalls in Graskop and Sabie, Lisbon and Berlin Falls, Gods Window and the Gold Rush territory. (B, L, D)

September 9: Full Day Kruger Safari game drive. (B, L, D)

September 10: Fly back to Johannesburg this afternoon to prepare for your evening flights home. (B)

#### Itinerary:

September 6: Fly to Cape Town from Johannesburg. Upon arrival, settle into your hotel. Enjoy dinner at the Gold Restaurant before GOLD Restaurant is a Pan-African experience in the heart of Cape Town. Enjoy an interactive drum circle and learn to play the djembe to the sounds of Africa. (D)

September 7: Today we will enjoy a tour of the Peninsula. Start at Cape Point Nature Reserve which is the southernmost tip of Cape Town's south peninsula and is home to nearly 20% of Africa's flora. Visit Boulders Penguin Colony. Enjoy a boat cruise to observe the Cape Fur seal colony. Finish your day with a hands-on Bo-Kaap cooking experience guided by a mother and daughter team. (B, L, D)

September 8: Begin your day with a visit to Robben Island accompanied by a former prisoner. Take a ferry to the prison where Africa's political prisoners, including Nelson Mandela, were imprisoned. Robben Enjoy some leisure time at the Victoria & Alfred waterfront. This afternoon, take in the sights and sounds as you navigate the streets and learn more of the history and culture of South Africa's "Mother City". We'll take you past the Castle of Good Hope and City Hall; through the Company Gardens to see St. George's Cathedral, the Slave Tree, and the Houses of Parliament; wind our way through the curio stalls at Greenmarket Square and the colorful houses of the Bo Kaap; and more! (B, L, D)

September 9: Located on Table Mountain's eastern slopes is the beautiful Kirstenbosch Botanical Garden. The garden was established in 1914 and is the first of its kind to be devoted to a country's indigenous flora. Continue on to Stellenbosch to enjoy a wine tour throughout South Africa's premier wine producing area. Enjoy a tour and tasting. (B, L, D)

September 10: Schedule flights to fly home today.



**Details:** Minimum group size is 20. Maximum bus size is 35. Cape Town had many international direct flights back to the US. We recommend scheduling flights to return home from there instead of back track to Johannesburg.

September 8: Today you will visit the Chobe River. You will have the opportunity to enjoy a Chobe boat cruise where you will get up close to herds of animals. This area has the highest concentration of Elephants globally. In the afternoon, experience a Chobe National Park game drive. (B, L, D)

September 9: Today is a free day to take advantage of the included lodge experiences.
