REVIEW OF THE RETAIL PRICE OF PETROL AND DIESEL

The Malawi Energy Regulatory Authority (MERA) has historically adopted Automatic Pricing Mechanism (APM) under which a movement in model parameters increase/decrease of more than 5% triggers an automatic price adjustment. However, in the last three years, this mechanism was abandoned in favour of a fixed pricing regime that proved to be commercially unsustainable. This led to significant trading losses, resulting in inability to import adequate petroleum products and inability to remit economically important levies like the Road Levy to the Road Fund Administration (RFA) and Rural Electrification Levy to Malawi Rural Electrification Programme (MAREP) Fund. This resulted in the deterioration of roads countrywide, and delayed implementation of important MAREP projects nationally.

Furthermore, the artificial pricing of petroleum products created arbitrage opportunities for smugglers, resulting in the country losing its scarce foreign exchange resources by subsidising foreign product demands, and depletion of important national Strategic Fuel Reserves (SFRs).

Under the APM, petrol and diesel qualify for price revision for the month of January 2026, since the landed cost of both products is beyond the 45% trigger band. Therefore, to sustain importation of petrol and diesel, pump prices of these petroleum products have been adjusted upwards **effective 20th January 2026** as follows:

By law, all operators are required to sell petroleum products at prices not exceeding the above approved regulated maximum pump prices.





Chipunga Centre for Youth and Rural Development (CCYRD) is a local non-profit making organization registered in June 2021 with a mission to transform lives for children, young people and women through providing quality education and livelihoods enhancement initiatives. CCYRD is managed by Executive Director, Projects Coordinator and Finance Manager as a senior Management team on voluntary basis who report to Board of Directors.

The Projects are implemented directly by Community Based Volunteers in the local communities under supervision of Projects Coordinator who report to Executive Director. CCYRD has been involved in several projects since its partnership and funding support from GRACE charity in August 2020. The key activities include:

- Establishment of 2 Pre-Schools which includes the training of 4 caregivers on Early Childhood Development (ECD) and feeding program for the kids by utilizing clinics and other existing buildings not ideal for kindergarten.
- Providing learning and teaching materials in pre-schools and primary schools, feeding programs in selected primary schools, solar lighting, supporting schools with additional staff.
- Providing educational opportunities to students through bursaries.
- Supporting government run schools with building and infrastructure projects such as solar powered water supply, building teacher houses and classrooms and tailor-made initiatives to empower girls.

1. Project goal

GRACE shall co-operate with **CCYRD** in line with the project "**Installation of a Solar Powered Water Supply System servicing at Njiri Primary School**" as described in the project application (Annex 1) over a funding period starting on 02. February 2026 and ending on 30. June 2026.

Project purposes, target groups, measures:

- 1) To mobilize the **Njiri Community** and to ensure that the community contributes to the construction of a **Pump House and Tank Tower** according to the usual values of the supplier "solar & electrical installation technology". The community part towards tank tower and pump house construction includes brick production, providing quarry sand, timbers, planks, cement, and the labour fees for skilled workers.
- 2) To manage the community to dig ditches in step to and escorting the supplier.
- 3) To contract and to pay the supplier "solar & electrical installation technology".
- 4) To collect key performance indicators as measurables for the success of the project (number of kids washing hands after using toilets and days of illness ahead a year after completing of the project). CCYRD shall collect the data in a standardized way.
- 5) To sensitize 800 school pupils, 100 pre-school kids, and people in the surrounding areas on good hygiene practices and facilitate the installation and use of tippy taps.
- 6) To facilitate planting and preservation of trees around the school during rainy season.

In addition, the stakeholders at Chipunga community have agreed to contribute by accommodation and cash amounting of MKW 30'000 per month for the above stated period.

Payments will be made at the end of the month for the duration of this Agreement, commencing February 2026.

Terms and Conditions

- Use of Funds:** The funds provided by GRACE Charity shall be exclusively used for the payment of the science secondary school teacher at CDSS.
- Reporting:** CCYRD will deliver a monthly payment note. CCYRD will provide a final report detailing the impact of the teacher's support to the school and to the success of the learners (based on measurable KPIs).
- Termination:** Either party may terminate this Agreement with a written notice of 30 days, given that all outstanding payments are settled.
- Foundation:** Binding and ruling basis of this service is the agreement between CCYRD and Ms. Hilda Wiskes.
