

Packing List

What to Bring:

- Light & thick layers. Be prepared for hot, wet, and cold weather.
- Please consider safety, modesty, and messaging when choosing attire to bring to camp.
- Closed toe footwear for running/climbing
- Rubber boots
- Water shoes/sandals (to prevent cutting feet while walking in the river)
- Swimming suit. Tshirts must be worn over swimsuits.
- Bedding-Sleeping bag/bed sheets and/or blankets (mattresses are already provided)
- Toiletries-toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, soap
- Towel/face cloth (please not your nicest one)
- Bible
- Notebook, pen/pencil
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen

What you COULD bring:

- Sun hat
- Bug spray
- Sunglasses

What NOT to bring:

- Personal devices (cellphone/ipad/tablet/e-reader/iPod/gaming console)
- Illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco/nicotine, vapes, or cigarettes.
- Vulgar or immodest clothing/swimwear
- Extra money for TUCK... this is included in registration fees
