CAMPAIGN FOR SPIRITUAL RENEWAL
SOWING SEEDS OF FAITH



My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,

We just concluded Catholic Schools Week. We continue to thank God for the gift of our Parochial School which has been a vital part of our ministry of evangelization. Catholic education is an extension of the ministry of Jesus Christ in proclaiming the Good News. We honor all those involved in our School.

This weekend we launch the public phase of the Campaign for Spiritual Renewal. From this day forward, for the next few months, we will be talking about this invitation to grow spiritually as disciples of Jesus. It is seldom that we are invited to be part of an endeavor that is far bigger than ourselves that will take us to a future where the spiritual welfare of future generations of parishioners is being prepared and hallowed by us, the current generation of believers.

The Campaign is aptly called Sowing Seeds of Faith Campaign for Spiritual Renewal. The theme of the Campaign is Renewed in Christ, Together in Mission. It highlights the many aspects of the Campaign - the spiritual rootedness in Christ, the aim to be renewed in Him, the journey together in the mission evangelization. Indeed, it is a bold step forward in our journey together in Christ's mission. This is a product of many consultations and prayerful reflection that aims to strengthen our parishes, our schools, formation programs, ministries not only for us but for the future of the Catholic Church in Santa Clara County.

During this time of the year, winter-spring timeframe, we normally embark on the Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA). However, this year, we are combing the Sowing Seeds of Faith (SSF). **Out combined goal for both endeavors is \$953,000. For SSF it is \$840,000 which we need to raise in 5 years through pledges, and for this year's ADA, it is \$113,000.** After the end of the Campaign, **50% of what we will raise** will stay right here in the Parish for our own needs and dreams, **AND, 80% of every dollar raised over our goal** will stay at the Parish.

The Co-Chairs of the Parish Campaign Committee (PCC) are Rom Dizon, our perennial ADA Chair, whose success has been matched by his dedication to help the Parish achieve financial stability, and Thomas Sites, a school parent who has been actively involved the education of their sons in the School. There are other members of the PCC whom you will meet through the coming months.

As a community of faith, in which every person plays an important role as members of the Body of Christ, I am asking the rest of you to consider your part by making a pledge to the Campaign. We are depending on 100% participation because we want everyone to have made an investment in this faith that is so important to each of us.

Members of the Committee will be calling on you to sit down with you and explain the plan of the Campaign so that united in Christ, we shall work together in making his Kingdom a reality here in our Parish.

I, along with Father Victor, also look forward to sitting down with you to talk about the future of our Parish, rooted in our common love for God and the Church.

May God bless you always.



GOSPEL MEDITATION

The Gospel Reading for today is what is popularly called the Sermon on the Mount. Many think it is the absolute epitome of Jesus' teachings. To be sure it tells us how we are to live our lives, the attitudes we are to have. We must remember that those who were waiting and hoping for the Messiah expected a military leader, one who would lead them in battle against their oppressors.

In His Sermon on the Mount Jesus gives a more accurate perspective of Who He is. He begins what we call the Beatitudes (the word means "blessings") with "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." In a sense we are all "poor in spirit." Without the guidance and strength provided us by the Lord there is no way we can escape this poverty of spirit, of spirituality, if you will.

That is why we often say that living God-centered lives is at the very core of stewardship. Being a disciple of Christ translates into being a steward of our many gifts and blessings. Some scholars believe that Jesus may have given this sermon often during His ministry. Those who followed Jesus and became the earliest Christians, the first members of the Church, were fond of quoting and referring to what the Lord said on this occasion. As stated, Jesus provides us with the secret of living a good life. If we rely on Him and follow Him, we will be blessed.


The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults
