**JUST AROUND THE CORNER ALREADY**  
**WELCOMING LENT**

**My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,**

This coming Wednesday, February 18, we will enter into the yearly exercise of Lent, “awaiting the sacred paschal feasts with joy of minds made pure, in order to be led to the fullness of grace” (Preface of Lent I). We do so with great anticipation preparing our hearts and minds for the Paschal Mystery, the gift and promise of our future resurrection.

I invite you all to participate in the different prayer opportunities and liturgies of the holy season so that we may derive from those opportunities the fullness of God’s love and mercy.

We have already published our Lenten 2026 schedule, in the bulletin and on our social media platforms. Please refer to them as they have been carefully planned by the Liturgy Committee for the benefit of the Parish.

**Mary Lee Brock** is an assistant professor in the Helder College of Business at the Jesuit-run Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska. I wish to quote a portion of a mediation she wrote on the University’s online ministries page:

*“When I travel, I enjoy the opportunity to learn more about my destination. Dining in a neighborhood restaurant can be such a pleasure. The local news can provide insights into events, reactions to the weather, and what the community values. I also enjoy attending Mass in a church I have never been to before... sometimes at a church not frequented by tourists and sometimes at a well-known cathedral. When I visit a new church, I see how parishioners interact with one another, look for meaning in the architecture, wonder about the history of the parish, and marvel at what must have been sacrificed to build the church. Whatever the setting, I find comfort in the universality of the liturgy. And during Ordinary Time, I find visiting other parishes in my own community reanimates my engagement with liturgy and community.*

*As I pray with today’s readings, images from my attending liturgies during my travels come to mind. A church built of concrete blocks outside of Cancun City; I felt the presence of God. The church in Brooklyn, where my parents were married before moving to the Midwest, I felt the presence of God. An elaborate, beautiful Cathedral; I felt the presence of God. An unfamiliar suburban parish in my own town; I felt the presence of God.”* (<https://onlineministries.creighton.edu/daily-reflections/daily-reflection-february-9-2026>).

This got me thinking of our parish. Before every Mass on Sunday, the presider welcomes the Assembly to the celebration. We ask if there are guests or visitors so that we can acknowledge their presence in our midst. I wonder if those visitors and guests “**feel the presence of God**” because they are with us and we reflect God to them and to each other.

The purpose of the *Sowing Seeds of Faith Campaign* is to bring about a deep spiritual renewal among us, the People of God, in the Diocese of San Jose, here at St. John the Baptist Parish in Milpitas.

I pray that this “sacred time given us for the renewing and purifying of our hearts” may allow us to look forward to things that eternally endure”.

This coming Tuesday, February 17, our brothers and sisters from the Orient, will celebrate the Lunar New Year. We wish them all the blessings of the Almighty: good health, prosperity, serenity of heart and a peaceful spirit.

Finally, please join us for Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent. It starts at 7 p.m., except on First Friday of the month. Different parish organizations will lead each Friday night and will sponsor meatless soup meal. Father Victor and I will give a brief meditation on a particular station every Friday of Lent.


