PASTOR'S MESSAGE

SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT

MARCH 1, 2026

COME BACK TO ME, WITH ALL YOUR HEART

BE TRANSFIGURED



My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,

In the Old Testament, the prophet Hosea cries out to the holy people of God: *“O Israel, come back! Return to your GOD! You’re down but you’re not out. Prepare your confession and come back to GOD. Pray to him, “Take away our sin, accept our confession. Receive as restitution our repentant prayers.”*

“I will heal their waywardness. I will love them lavishly. My anger is played out. I will make a fresh start with Israel. He’ll burst into bloom like a crocus in the spring. He’ll put down deep oak tree roots, he’ll become a forest of oaks! He’ll become splendid—like a giant sequoia, his fragrance like a grove of cedars!

Those who live near him will be blessed by him, be blessed and prosper like golden grain. Everyone will be talking about them, spreading their fame as the vintage children of God. Ephraim is finished with gods that are no-gods. From now on I’m the one who answers and satisfies. (Hos 14:1-8)

This is a perpetual and heart-felt invitation from God to his beloved people spoken through Hosea during a time of prosperity in Israel, yet fraught with infidelity and turning to outward forces. Likening God’s relationship with Israel as a marriage covenant, Hosea pleads with the people to return to God with all their heart and not allow fear, sin, indifference and disloyalty keep them apart.

Let us reflect on this relationship with our God as we continue with our Lenten journey. By now, you may have gotten hold of our Lenten Schedule here at St. John.

Last Sunday, the gospel took us to the wilderness and saw the drama of the temptations faced by the Lord, who was offered bread, fame, glory and control. As tempting as these offers were, Jesus resisted them at every turn, rooting himself in complete obedience to the will of the Father and relying on the eternal word of God.

On this second Sunday of Lent, the gospel takes us to Mount Tabor, the place of glorification and preview of the majesty of the Resurrection by experiencing the mystery of the **Transfiguration**. Before the incredulous eyes of the three disciples, Peter, James and John, in the presence of the giant figures of the Hebrew people, Moses and Elijah, the Lord Jesus was transfigured into an image that they have never seen before. Having been dazzled by the majesty of Jesus, they wanted to remain in that place. Peter exclaimed: *“Ah, Lord! It is good that we are here.”* But we say: **“Ah, Lord, transfigure us.”**

We too are tempted to not leave the mountain, the place of glorification, the place of revelation of God’s majesty. But there is work to be done. Jesus needs to go back down the valley, work and toil, only to ascend another mountain - Calvary, the mountain of sacrifice, of immolation, of complete surrender.

It is interesting to note that our own Santa Clara Valley where we live is nestled between two mountain ranges - the Diablo Range in the northwest and the Santa Cruz Mountains in the southwest. The Silicon Valley between the Devil and the Holy Cross. As Catholic Christians, we know whom to turn to during moments of temptations.

Other than our traditional Stations of the Cross every Friday in Lent, this year, we have two opportunities before Holy Week for spiritual renewal, the main goal of our pastoral plan as we sow seeds of faith.

This coming **Saturday, March 7**, we shall have an opportunity for prayer and reflection during a **morning of Lenten recollection**. **Sr. Patricia Galli, RSM**, will lead us in a four-hour immersion in the presence of God with fellow parishioners. The goal is to enhance our relationship with God and with one another so as to strengthen each other in carrying the cross of Lent with our Savior, Jesus Christ. From **8:30 am to 12:30 pm**, Sr. Pat will take us to a **Journey of Hope** in order to make fruitful our experience of Lent.

The second event is the **Communal Celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation or Penance** on **Tuesday, March 17 at 7 pm**. Through this sacrament, we heed the prophetic call: *“Come back to me!”* We will have an opportunity to go to confession in order to prepare our heart and soul to walk with Jesus with humility and contrition as he makes his *via dolorosa*, his way of the Cross. We have invited several priests to be ministers of confession and reconciliation by dispensing God’s mercy and forgiveness.

I look forward to seeing you at these events. A Blessed Lent to you all.


