

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

MARCH 22, 2026

"LAZARUS, COME OUT"

(JN 11:43c)



My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,

When we entered Lent on February 18 last, we were signed with ashes in the form of a cross. One of the formulae used in the signing was: "Remember, man, that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return." It was a star reminder of our origin and destination: from clay which God formed in his own hands, and unto the dust which God redeemed by the loving hands of Jesus stretched out on the Cross of salvation.

While St. Paul said: "The wages of sin is death" (Rom 6:23a) he also asked: "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?" (1 Cor 15:55). Death is inevitability no one can escape. It is part of human condition. Since the time of our birth, the time of our death started to also roll. Death is certain, but what happens after death is a certainty offered solely by the grace of God to those who love him and serve him and are faithful to his commands. Again, St. Paul continues: "the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Rom 6:23b).

When Jesus was informed about the illness of Lazarus, Jesus did not rush to his bedside to heal his friend. He said: "This illness is not to end in death, but is for the glory of God." (Jn 11:4).

What Jesus is saying is that even in illness, and eventually in death, God's glory is revealed. The ashes of Lent are intimately connected to the grave, the tomb which is the destiny of our human remains. But our soul is destined for eternal life which is a gift (grace) from God, through Jesus Christ.

On this fifth Sunday of Lent, the Lord invites us, like he does to Lazarus, to come out of the tombs of our making: fear, prejudices, despair, addiction, wastefulness, wrong or unhealthy relationships, war, violence, indifference – all these that lead us to moral or spiritual imprisonment. Jesus came to set prisoners free, and we have imprisoned ourselves in our self-made tombs. So Jesus says to us: "Come out!"

As Holy Week approaches, I would like to invite you to take advantage of our Holy Week celebrations and liturgies. They have been so scheduled for our spiritual edification and renewal.

May we continue to be strengthened by the grace of Lent. I look forward to seeing you at our Holy Week events. A Blessed Lent to you all.
