## **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

*ELEVENTH SUNDAY  
IN ORDINARY TIME  
JUNE 14, 2026*



***HIS HEART WAS MOVED WITH PITY***

***My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,***

Last Friday, we celebrated the solemnity of the most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Today, I would like to reflect with you the concept of being called by the compassionate heart of the Lord.

In the first reading from the book of Exodus, we heard the Lord God saying to Moses: "I bore you up on eagle wings and brought you here to myself. Therefore, if you hearken to my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all other people, though all the earth is mine. You shall be to me a kingdom of priests, a holy nation." (Ex 19:4b-6a)

It is a constant reminder, not only for the people of the Old Covenant, but also and especially for us, the redeemed people of the New Covenant, because, we were purchased by the precious blood of Jesus. St. Paul affirms that in the second reading from his letter to the Romans: "God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us." (Rom 6:8)

All this comes from God's fundamental attitude towards His people: mercy and compassion.

We see this in the gospel this weekend from St. Matthew: "Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd." (Mt 9:36).

It was out of mercy and compassion that Jesus wanted to guarantee the continuation of his ministry in the world through the ministry of the Apostles he called. The ministry of the apostles and those who followed them is a ministry of continuation - the ministry of Jesus must go on beyond his earthly time, beyond our earthly time.

We are called to the ministry of sowing seeds of faith. Jesus' ministry must not break or stop with us. That is our continuing challenge. We can do it.

### The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

We are now accepting registration for the next OCIA Process which will start on 19 July 2026, after the 10 am Mass. The QR Code for the registration form is located on the parish website (SJBPparish.org under drop-down tab formation (OCIA), or you can use the QR code here. After you submit your registration form, you will be contacted, and we will schedule an in-person interview so we can fully understand what you are looking for and how we can help with your Journey of Faith.

ORDER of CHRISTIAN INITIATION



If you are not sure if you want to commit to the OCIA Process because you think you will be locked into a long-term commitment, register for the OCIA Process and attend a few sessions, if it isn't what you are looking for you can withdraw at any time with no implications. I would ask you to NOT pay the \$100. Fee until Oct or Nov 2026 to make sure that this is what you are looking for.

OCIA is open to anyone in the Parish that would like to attend to learn more about their faith. If you think you might be interested in the Catholic Faith, come join us and see if it answers your questions.

## FAITH FORMATION

### CELEBRATIONS OF SACRAMENT

Baptism are being celebrated every Saturday at 10:00 am, 12:00 pm, and 2:00 pm. Please make an appointment with the Parish Office to schedule a Baptism interview and to register for the required preparation class. The preparation class is being held every second and fourth Thursday of the month at 6:30 PM.

### FIRST EUCHARIST

We accept children who are at least in first grade and seven years old. We have two classes: one is every Thursday from 6:45 pm to 8:00 pm and the other is every Saturday from 9:15 am to 10:30 am. Registration starts in late July or early August.

### CONFIRMATION

It is a two-year program. First Year Confirmandi meet every first and third Friday while Second Year Confirmandi meet every second and fourth Friday. Both will have a mandatory Confirmation Retreat. Regular Class time is 6:30 pm to 8:45 pm. We accept children who are at least in seventh grade and up to Junior High (eleventh grade). Registration starts in late July or early August.

### MARRIAGE

Before planning your wedding, please make an appointment with one of our priest. Marriage preparation usually takes at least six months period to complete.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Extra-Ordinary Ministers of the Holy Eucharist make pastoral visit to parishioners who are sick either confined in the hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, care homes, or at the convenient of their own home. Also, it is for parishioners who are homebound, i.e. their health or medical conditions could be compromised when they leave home. Pastoral visit comprise of the respectful distribution of the Holy Eucharist to the sick; and as well, as giving them emotional, social, and spiritual support through profound and thoughtful prayers.

### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

In this Church's Sacrament, through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them from sin – and sometimes even from physical ailment. There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness or frailty of old age is sufficient. To request, please call the parish office.

Outside office hours, kindly call (408) 966-4612. In addition, the Sacrament is also conferred during the communal celebration at the morning Mass every first Saturday of the month.
