PASTOR'S MESSAGE

CAMPAIGN FOR SPIRITUAL RENEWAL
AND THE ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL

My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,

Last Wednesday, June 24, we celebrated the solemnity of the birth of St. John the Baptist, our patron. It was a wonderful celebration that started last weekend with a mini-festival, a Triduum of Masses from June 21-23, and a Fiesta Mass and Dinner on the feast day itself. I wish to thank all those who participated and helped in the celebration of our fiesta. I thank God for all of you.

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As many of you know, the **Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA)** takes place each February and supports the regular operations of shared ministries and services that no single parish in the Diocese of San Jose can sustain on its own.

The **Campaign for Spiritual Renewal** which we have been praying for in our parish before every Sunday Mass is called **Sowing Seeds of Faith (SSOF) Campaign**. It is a diocesan-wide campaign for spiritual renewal that supports our Pastoral Plan. Unlike a typical capital campaign focused on buildings, this effort is about renewing our mission, strengthening faith formation, supporting vocations, and helping every parish bring the Pastoral Plan to life in their community.

The SSOF campaign started to roll out in waves across all parishes: Pilot parishes ran August-December 2025; Wave 1 parishes are running January-June 2026; and Wave 2 parishes will run July-December 2026. St. John the Baptist Parish is in Wave 1.

Is there an Annual Diocesan Appeal in 2026? For 2026 only, the ADA is integrated into the SSOF Campaign. There is no separate ADA appeal this year. Each parish has a SSOF goal that includes their ADA goal as a component. The ADA will return as a separate annual appeal in 2027. Our Parish goal for the SSOF Campaign is \$840,000 which includes our ADA 2026 goal of \$114,000.

How does this benefit our parish? The Sowing Seeds of Faith Campaign is an opportunity for parishioners to support both the diocese's shared ministries and their own parish community through a single, unified effort to spiritually renew our diocese. Once our parish meets its ADA goal through the SSOF campaign, 50% of all additional funds raised will come back to our parish to implement the Pastoral Plan locally.

For the past month and a half, I have been meeting with parishioners to invite them to participate in the SSOF Campaign for spiritual renewal. This is called the "silent phase" of the Campaign. During the last two weeks of July, the Campaign in the Parish will go "public". Likewise, I will be inviting you to pray and discern a sacrificial gift to the SSOF campaign for spiritual renewal. Your gift to this campaign supports the ministries typically funded by the ADA while also helping our parish and diocese bring the Pastoral Plan to life. This diocesan-wide campaign, unfolding in all parishes throughout this year, invites each of us to consider how God is calling us to support the spiritual renewal of our Diocese.

In the meantime, thank you for your continued generosity and for walking with us as we discern how God is calling our community to grow.

May St. John the Baptist, our patron, and all our friends in heaven intercede for us,
God bless you always.

CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

Baptism – Celebrated every Saturday at 10:00 AM, 12:00 PM, and 2:00 PM. Contact the Parish Office to schedule an interview and register for the required preparation class, held on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays at 6:30 PM.

First Eucharist

For children at least 7 years old and in first grade or higher. Classes are offered on Thursdays (6:45–8:00 PM) or Saturdays (9:15–10:30 AM). Registration begins in late July or early August.

Confirmation

A two-year program for students in grades 7–11. Classes meet twice monthly from 6:30–8:45 PM, with a required retreat. Registration begins in late July or early August.

Marriage

Please meet with a priest before making wedding plans. Marriage preparation typically takes at least six months.

Pastoral Care of the Sick

Extraordinary Ministers bring Holy Communion and spiritual support to parishioners who are sick, hospitalized, in care facilities, or homebound.

Anointing of the Sick

Available to those seriously ill or experiencing the frailty of old age. Contact the Parish Office or call (408) 966-4612 after office hours. The sacrament is also offered at the morning Mass on the First Saturday of each month.

We are now accepting registration for the next OCIA Process, which will start on 19 July 2026, after the 10 am Mass. The QR Code for the registration form is located on the parish website (SJBPParish.org under drop-down tab formation (OCIA), or you can use the QR code here. After you submit your registration form, you will be contacted, and we will schedule an in-person interview so we can fully understand what you are looking for and how we can help with your Journey of Faith.

If you are not sure if you want to commit to the OCIA Process because you think you will be locked into a long-term commitment, register for the OCIA Process and attend a few sessions, if it isn't what you are looking for you can withdraw at any time with no implications. I would ask you NOT to pay the \$100. Fee until Oct or Nov 2026 to make sure that this is what you are looking for.

OCIA is open to anyone in the Parish who would like to attend to learn more about their faith. If you think you might be interested in the Catholic Faith, come join us and see if it answers your questions.
