STORM SEASON IS HERE, IS YOUR BOAT READY?

Australia's storm season runs from November to April, bringing the risk of strong winds, heavy rain, and cyclones, particularly in northern and coastal regions. Whether your boat is moored, berthed, or trailered, preparation is key.

Moorings and Marinas

- Inspect moorings, lines, and fittings for wear or corrosion
- Use double lines and chafe protection where possible
- Know your marina or club's storm policy
- Remove or secure loose gear on deck

Insurance

- Review your policy to confirm coverage for storm damage, salvage, and environmental cleanup
- Keep recent photos and an inventory of your vessel and equipment

Be Storm-Ready

- Charge batteries and check bilge pumps are working
- Prepare a storm plan: where your boat will go, how you'll secure it, and who will assist if you're away
- Stay informed via BOM, marine safety authorities, and local radio channels
