We are looking to add a full-time Automatic Side-Load truck driver to our team. As our residential division grows, demand for skilled drivers increases as well.

About the Team/Department

Our side-arm team is comprised of hard-working, highly skilled drivers who are up to the task of meeting daily demands. This role reports directly to our operations manager.

About the role

For the most part, our side-arm drivers have consistent routes servicing residential and commercial customers. This role requires the ability to learn a base route and be ready to alter and optimize even daily as customers are added. Excellent driving skills and safety are required as side-arm drivers often need to get into tight spaces to service customers. Our drivers work together to meet the needs of our customers, so side-arm drivers must communicate effectively and be willing team players. Full-time side-arm drivers usually have a dedicated truck that they are familiar with. This is a Monday-Friday position, with the exception of altered schedules during holiday weeks. Side-arm drivers usually arrive to prep trucks and begin their routes at 4:00 am.

What you'll do

In this role, you will use a specialized truck to haul waste or debris in 96-gallon carts, from primarily residential and commercial sites. While you are not expected to help with loading and unloading on every job, you should feel comfortable securing trash in a dumpster for proper unloading into the truck. Our ideal applicant has trucking experience or is comfortable using a radio, phone, and tablet to communicate with other drivers and dispatch.
