Crocheron & John Golden Park is a public park and a level I arboretum in Bayside, Queens. The 62 acre park has running/walking paths, 9 athletic courts/fields, early 20th century gazebos, catch-and-release fishing, and 29 multilingual tree tags designed by NYC Parks and the Urban Park Rangers.

The park is supported by Friends of Crocheron & John Golden Park, grassroots organization made up of local volunteers who host free events and advocate for park improvements.
