Dress Code, Cell Phone, Smoking

& Other Policies

Good judgement, good taste, and cooperation are mandatory regarding proper attire. Dressing appropriately shows respect for fellow members and for the Club. Our dress code applies to all members and guests and members are responsible for their guests at all times.

- In the clubhouse house, men's shirts must have sleeves and collars and it's recommended they be tucked in unless specifically made to be worn outside the pants or shorts (i.e., tropical shirts). A turtleneck or mock turtleneck is considered a collared shirt. Sweaters and Henley collared shirts are also acceptable.
 - Please note, men must tuck their shirts in while on the golf course, on the practice range, or on the short game practice area.
- Women: Tops with collars or sleeves; slacks, shorts, long or cropped (capri) pants, leggings permitted with skirts or dresses, finger-tip length or longer tops & dresses, shoes or boots.
 - Women's sleeveless or spaghetti strap dress or top that is part of an outfit is acceptable as long as it does not bare any midriff and is of a conservative cut.
 - Mid-thigh length skirts and shorts are appropriate.
- Tasteful denim is acceptable.
 - Please no ripped, frayed or holes.
- No shoes with cleats or like surfaces are allowed in the Drake Room.
- Sport hats are permitted on the patio or in the bar area. Members are to remove hats in the Drake Room at all times unless medically required.
 - All hats worn on the patio or in the bar area must be worn in the traditional forward-facing position.
- Cell phones are permitted in the lobby, locker rooms, and patio area only. Cell phones should be turned to "vibrate" at all times while on Club property.
- Smoking, e-cigarettes, and/or vaping is prohibited inside the Clubhouse and on the patio.
- No outside food or beverages may be brought onto the Twin Beach property.
- In accordance with our Club Liquor License, a "corking fee" of \$25 will be applicable to any member that brings in their own bottle of wine.
