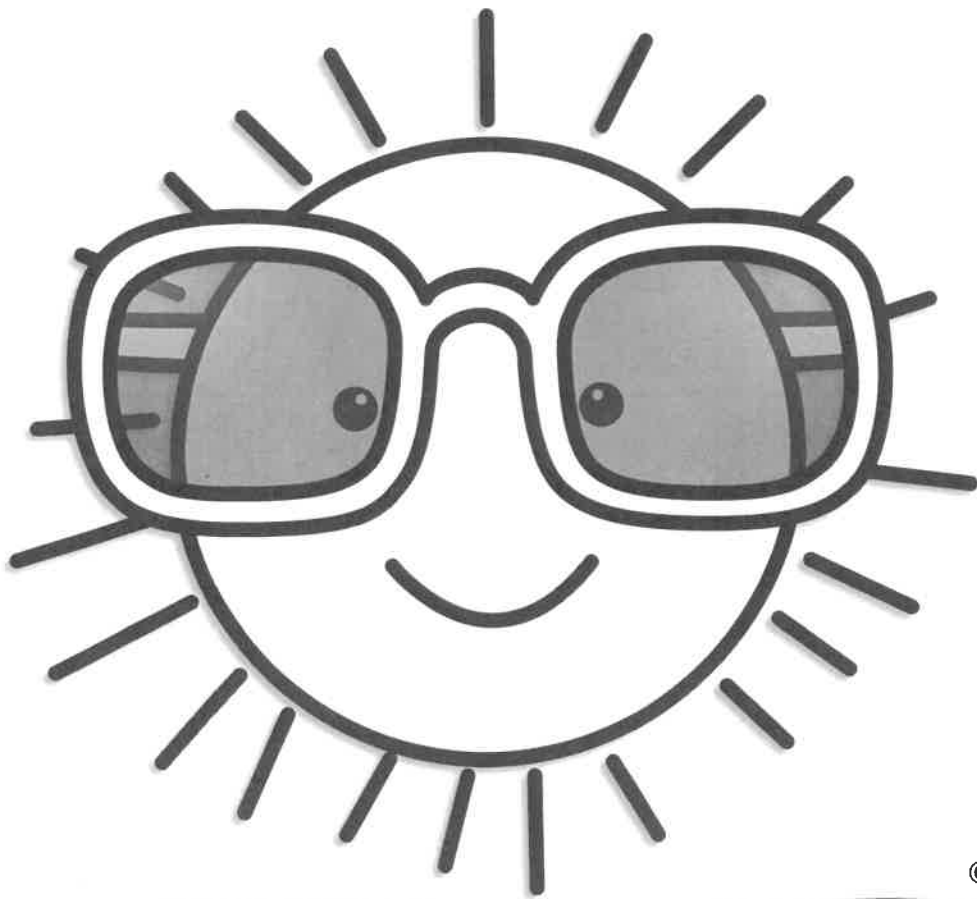

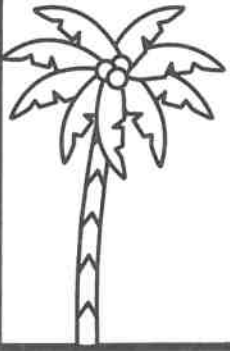

- Describe your perfect summer day.







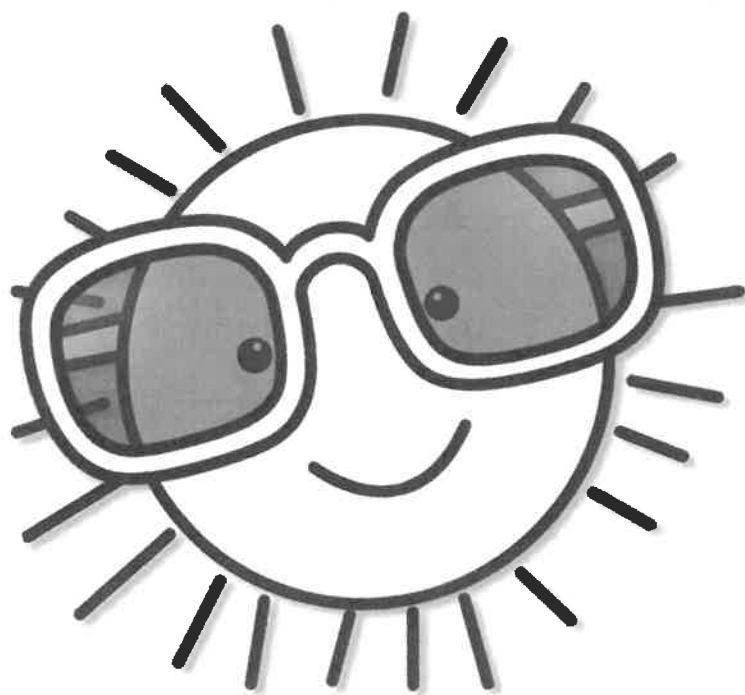

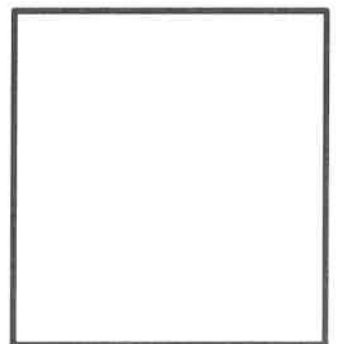
