We successfully completed all the transition documents for the children going to school. We are really proud how all the children have developed and our role in contributing towards their next stage in life.

Survey (you spoke and we have listened)

We have now collated all the feedback and many thanks to all the Parents for their feedback.

There was so much information that was quite emotional in respect to how positive many aspects were.

Once area which was highlighted was the electronic learning journals and the regularity of feedback. So we have listened and will now aim consistently for at least one observation each week for each child.

Of course every child is unique and attendances vary from each child. Please do also speak to your keyworker because many pictures and observations need approval so they may be stacked waiting to be released.

We would like to mention and it is important to let all parents know that the authorities want our Early Years Practitioners focussed on planning (intent) and teaching the children from the curriculum. They do not really want our team spending time on the tablets, taking photo's of the children, instead of teaching which is always the priority. Nevertheless we will aim for at least one observation.

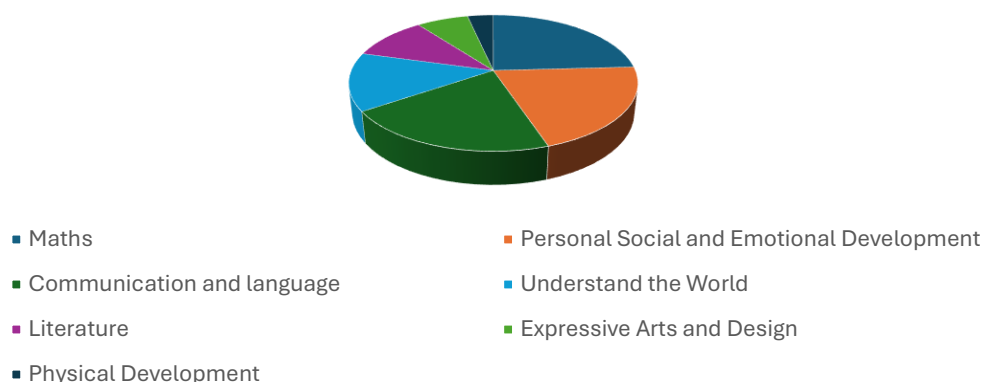
Pupils Premium

Pupils Premium - Areas identified for learning in Summer 2026

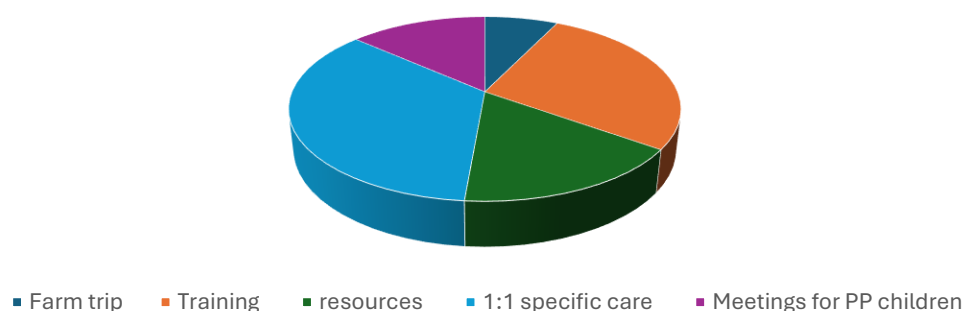


Our expenditure (approximately 8k in the term) was as follows:
