

A message from the Pastor

Jesus' Project of Liberation

Today's message is brief, because I invite you all to focus on the schedule for Holy Week and Easter celebrations. As Jesus liberates Lazarus from the tomb, we prepare to celebrate the passion, death, and resurrection, when Jesus liberates us from death. We prepare to enter these celebrations bringing our whole person: our worries and fears, our hopes and dreams. Come, let us celebrate our liberation together!

Holy Week and Easter Schedule:

Saturday, March 28 6pm: Palm Sunday Mass *No Confessions*

Palm Sunday Celebrations at Chicano Park: This year we will be celebrating two Palm Sunday masses on Sunday, March 29 at Chicano Park at the 10:30am and 12:30pm masses. Blessings of the Palms will take place in playground of the school at 10 am and 12 pm, after which we will process through the alleyway over the pedestrian bridge to Chicano Park to celebrate the Eucharist. Please follow instructions from our ushers and security team by obeying traffic signals. Those who are unable to make the walk can meet us at Chicano Park. There will be chairs set up at the park for mass.

Holy Thursday Procession: At the end of the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper, there will be a Eucharistic procession from the church to the Altar of Repose in the Parish Hall. Please follow instructions from our ushers and security team. Those who are unable to make the walk can meet us at the Parish Hall.

The Way of the Cross: Live reenactment of the stations of the cross will begin at 12pm on Friday, April 3 at Chicano Park on the Bay (1449 Cesar E. Chavez Parkway), concluding in front of the church. Please follow instructions from our ushers and security team.

Liturgy of the Passion of the Lord: 6pm Friday, April 3 inside the church.

Pésame a la Virgen: At the conclusion of the 6pm Liturgy of the Passion of the Lord, we will accompany Jesus to his burial site. After which, those wishing to accompany Our Mother in her sorrows can head back into the church to participate in the Pésame a la Virgen.
