A message from the Pastor

You are not forgotten

by Kimberly Morales, Co-Navigator of Pope Francis Center

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples, "Do not be afraid." He repeats this message several times because He knows that following Him will not always be easy. There will be moments of uncertainty, fear, and even suffering. Yet Jesus reminds us that God sees everything and that we are never forgotten in His eyes. As I reflected on this passage, I immediately thought about observing in the immigration court and my work at the Pope Francis Center. Every week, I am present at court and witness families going through some of the most difficult moments of their lives. Many arrive carrying fear, uncertainty, and heartbreak. They do not know what the outcome of their hearing, ICE check in, will be or what the future holds for them and their loved ones.

What stands out to me in this Gospel is when Jesus says that not even a sparrow falls to the ground without the Father knowing. That reminder feels especially meaningful when I think about the people I encounter in court. It can be easy for people to feel unseen in a large system, but this passage reminds me that every person who walks into that courtroom is known and loved by God. Their fears, their tears, their hopes, and their stories matter to Him. I am also reminded why accompaniment is so important. I cannot change what happens in the courtroom. I cannot take away a family's fear or guarantee a certain outcome. But I can be present. I can listen. I can bear witness.

Through the work of the Pope Francis Center, I also have the opportunity to walk alongside people during some of the hardest moments of their lives and remind them that they are not alone. There are days when the work feels heavy, especially when I see and hear about families impacted by detention and separation. In those moments, Jesus' words challenge me to keep showing up and to trust that God is present even when things feel uncertain.

At the end of the day, this passage reminds me that no one is forgotten by God. The families I meet, the individuals I meet and interact with at court, and the stories I carry with me are all held in His care. As I continue this work, I hope to be a small reminder to others that they are seen, valued, and never alone.
