Gloria I Choir

Grades 3-5 (school children only) Tuesdays 2:00-3:00 PM in School

Laudate Choir

Grades 6-12 (new members by audition only) Tuesdays 5:00-6:00 PM in Church. Teens with good singing skills are encouraged to join this group. This is the most advanced choir group. This group also plays bells.

Gloria II Choir

Grade 4-8 (all children welcome) Thursdays 5:00-6:00 PM in Church.

This last group is convenient for children attending REP. We simply walk to school after our rehearsal. There is a window of opportunity for Polish speaking children to attend Gloria II Choir. If we gather enough children who will commit to singing in Polish language, we will then extend Gloria II Choir time for 30 minutes and additional Polish music program.

Our Children's Choir is composed of three groups and children learn music from beginner to advanced. When we meet for Family Masses or Concerts together, we are one great group of enthusiastic young people who love to praise God through our singing. The children sing in many languages and exciting styles.

Gloria I and Gloria II Choirs are for beginners where we learn what we need to know about how to sing and begin to sing in simple two-part harmony. Laudate Choir sings in 2 to 4-part harmony and plays handbells and percussion instruments. New members can join by audition.

Children in 8th Grade who join during the 2025-26 Season will receive credit hours for their Confirmation. If they wish to audition for the High School Choir, Mrs. Fair can assist in their preparations. 8th Graders are invited to continue to sing with the Laudate Choir.

Along with mastering singing and learning new repertoire, the children develop friendships and make great memories. We participate in SJB Parish life, travel to other churches and music festivals like Pueri Cantores and sometimes we can be found in the Wisconsin Dells singing at St. Cecilia Church or going to the swimming pool.

Every member of SJB Children's Choir is required to pay a yearly fee of \$100.00 (siblings pay \$ 50.00) payable to SJB Church and must turn in the Consent Form to either the church office or school office to the attention of Ewa Fair.
