

Drop Off Procedure During the Parking Lot Repavement

Next week, our school parking lot will be repaved! Please see the diagrams below for drop-off and pick-up procedures. We will continue to use the same procedures we used during the carnival.

All families are asked to enter and exit from Main Street and use the church parking lot for both student drop-off and pick-up. (Please see the diagrams below) If you would like, you are welcome to park in the church lot and walk your child to the school entrance. Staff will be present to help guide traffic and ensure students arrive safely.

Preschool through second grade will continue to leave through the main doors.


Students in grades three through eight will leave from the garden doors near the PMC.


Our front parking lot will remain open, and cars can now enter and exit at any time.

Please use caution when walking through this parking lot. After school, all students will be dismissed through the front entrances of the building.

The patrol will no longer be stationed in the front parking lot after school; instead, they will be stationed near the church driveway. Also, please pass this information to any family or friend who may pick up your child.

Please note, our safety patrol is only present to guide students and families while crossing the driveway outside the church. They are dismissed around 3:05 pm. It is the families' responsibility to supervise their child (ren) once their classes are dismissed for the day.


St. John Brebeuf Children's Choir






