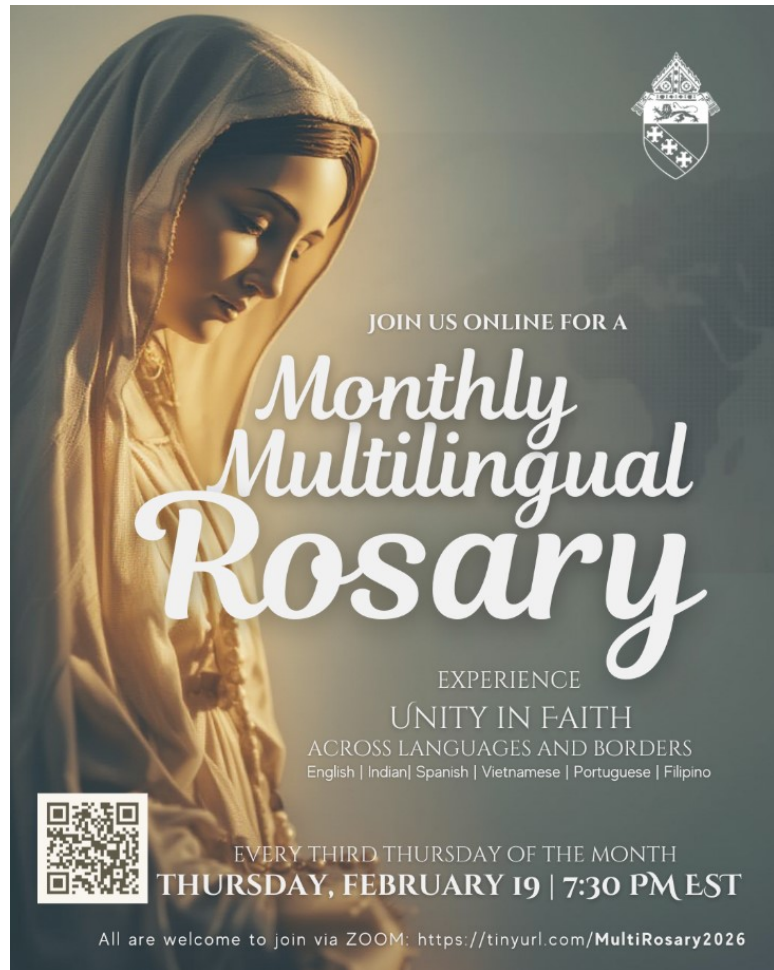




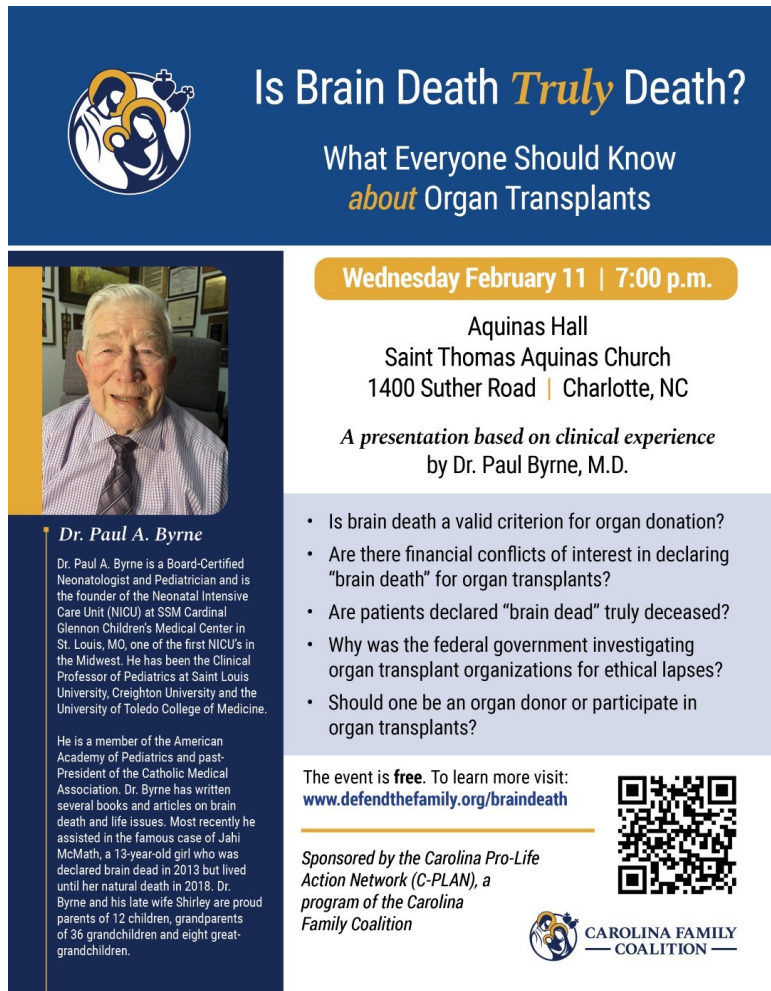

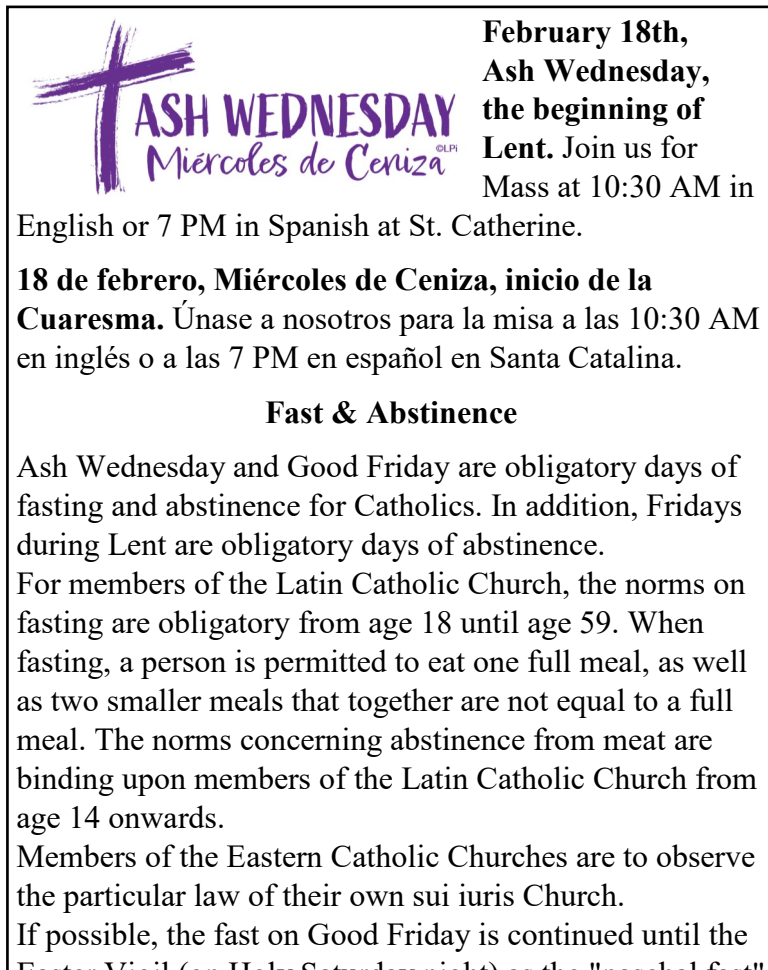
Dr. Paul A. Byrne
Dr. Paul A. Byrne is a Board-Certified Neonatologist and Pediatrician and is the founder of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at SSM Cardinal Glennon Children's Medical Center in St. Louis, MO, one of the first NICU's in the Midwest. He has been the Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at Saint Louis University, Creighton University and the University of Toledo College of Medicine.

He is a member of the American Academy of Pediatrics and past-President of the Catholic Medical Association. Dr. Byrne has written several books and articles on brain death and life issues. Most recently he assisted in the famous case of Jahi McMath, a 13-year-old girl who was declared brain dead in 2013 but lived until her natural death in 2018. Dr. Byrne and his late wife Shirley are proud parents of 12 children, grandparents of 36 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

- Is brain death a valid criterion for organ donation?
- Are there financial conflicts of interest in declaring "brain death" for organ transplants?
- Are patients declared "brain dead" truly deceased?
- Why was the federal government investigating organ transplant organizations for ethical lapses?
- Should one be an organ donor or participate in organ transplants?

Fast & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own sui iuris Church. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.
