

2024-2025 Admissions and Enrollment Fact Sheet

General Information

The Wellspring Schools is a full time Islamic school servicing students in 3K through 12th grade from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Wellspring students are engaged in a rigorous academic program aligned to the Next Generation New York State Standards (math, English language arts, science, and social studies). They are immersed in a comprehensive Islamic educational program that includes Quran, Tajweed, Arabic, and Islamic Studies. Additionally, they take specialty courses in art, technology, entrepreneurship, health, and physical education which completes their well-rounded education.

Wellspring has two additional educational programs for parents; Wellspring Studio and Wellspring Homeschool. Additional information can be found on our website.

2. What is the process for admissions? The process for admission is as follows:

1. Complete and submit an inquiry form found on our website

www.thewellspringschools.org

2. Upon submitting the inquiry form, you will receive an admissions checklist and an application.

** Please note, there is a \$200 non-refundable application and assessment fee**

3. After applying for admissions, the family will be scheduled with a school administrator for:

- a. Student academic assessment
- b. Parent interview

4. An admissions decision is made and the family will be notified.

5. If accepted, the family completes:

- a. An enrollment contract
- b. Enroll in Wellspring's Smart Tuition Payment Program
- c. The submission of a \$1,500 non-refundable deposit

The non-refundable deposit reserves your child's seat and is applied to the remaining tuition balance

Updated immunization records are required in order to complete the enrollment process

3. What are the tuition and any associated fees and what do they include?

- A. Discounted Tuition: \$7,995 (2 installment payments made in September and December).
- B. Regular Tuition: \$8,495 (7 installment payments made September through March).

***Please note: There are no sibling discounts.**

After School FAQs

1. I am interested in the after-school program. Please provide additional information about your programs.

The Wellspring After School Program services children ages 5 years of age and above. You can apply by going to www.thewellspringschools.org/after-school and complete the enrollment form. The fee is \$200 monthly. Upon receiving your enrollment form, you will be contacted by a Wellspring after school staff member.

There are free after school clubs and activities. The list is published each September via our website.

Transportation FAQs

1. What types of transportation services are available and what are their associated costs?

Wellspring has a private (door-to-door) bus service. The cost is \$2,000 per year. Upon enrollment, a family can request transportation services. We also have a bus that is serviced through the city where we are given 3 stops. In order to qualify for it, you have to live within a half-mile radius. The stops are:

- a. 129th St. & Kew Gardens
- b. Arlington & Liverpool St.
- c. Jamaica Ave & Sutphin Blvd.

****The deadline to apply for student transportation is July 1, 2024****

Scholarship FAQs

1. What forms of scholarships and/or tuition assistance are available?

1. New York City Scholarship Fund (Up to \$3,200, renewable through 8th grade).

2. How would I know if my family is eligible for tuition assistance scholarships?

Both scholarships are need-based (financial). Please check the Wellspring website for additional information about the criteria for both scholarships in the spring.

3. How and when would I receive approval or notification of scholarship funds?

Approval and/or notification of Wellspring scholarship takes place in the summer.



Approval and/or notification of NYC Children's Scholarship Fund takes place in the summer.

4. What happens if I am not approved for a tuition assistance scholarship?

Families who are not approved for a scholarship will be required to pay the full amount of the Wellspring tuition and fees.
