Children learn essential breathing exercises while their lung function is objectively measured and tracked in real-time.

It is the first and only truly interactive game with a spirometer-controller that teaches children breathing techniques through the game itself, without the need for extensive coaching by clinicians in institutions. Primary care providers and parents now have a way to teach breathing exercises and objectively monitor lung health in young children while remaining in the community.
