Statistics Example for Pantries

Unduplicated people served: each individual within a household should be counted once, regardless of how many times the household was served

Unduplicated households served: the person who picks up the food represents their household and each household is counted only once, regardless of how many times the household was served.

Total visits: every time someone picks up food, counts as one visit. If someone came 5 times in March, that counts as 5 total visits
